

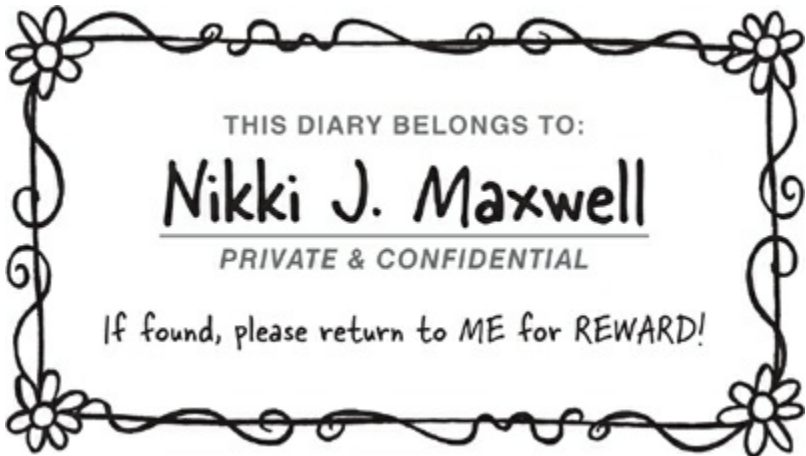

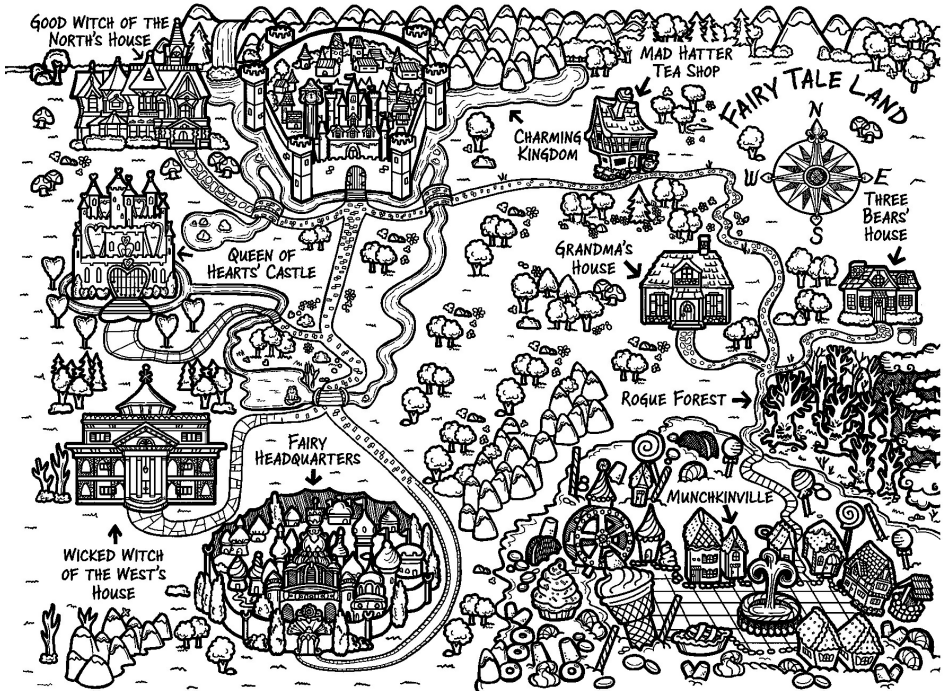

(That was me screaming in frustration!)

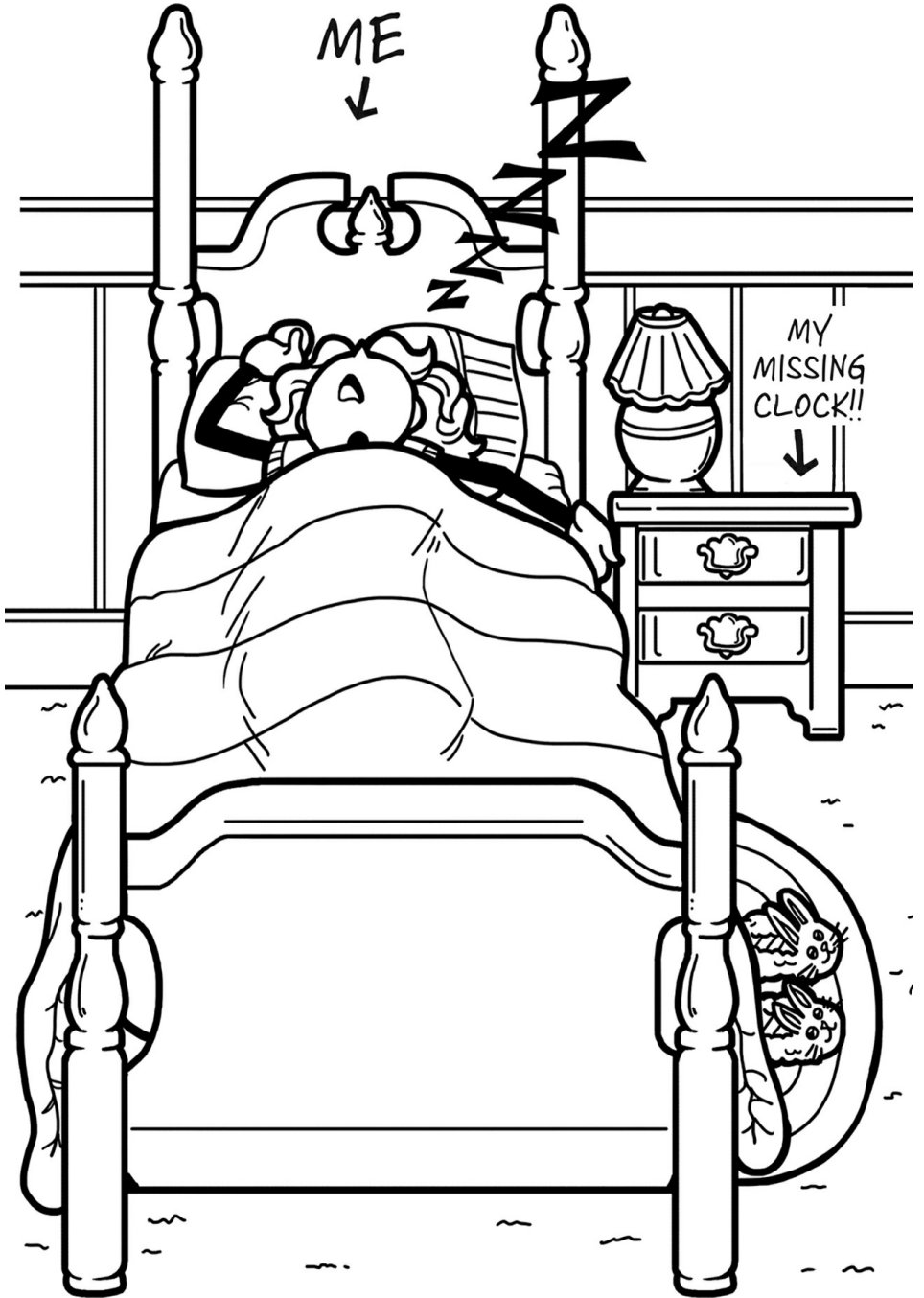

This is how my very CRUDDY day began. . . .



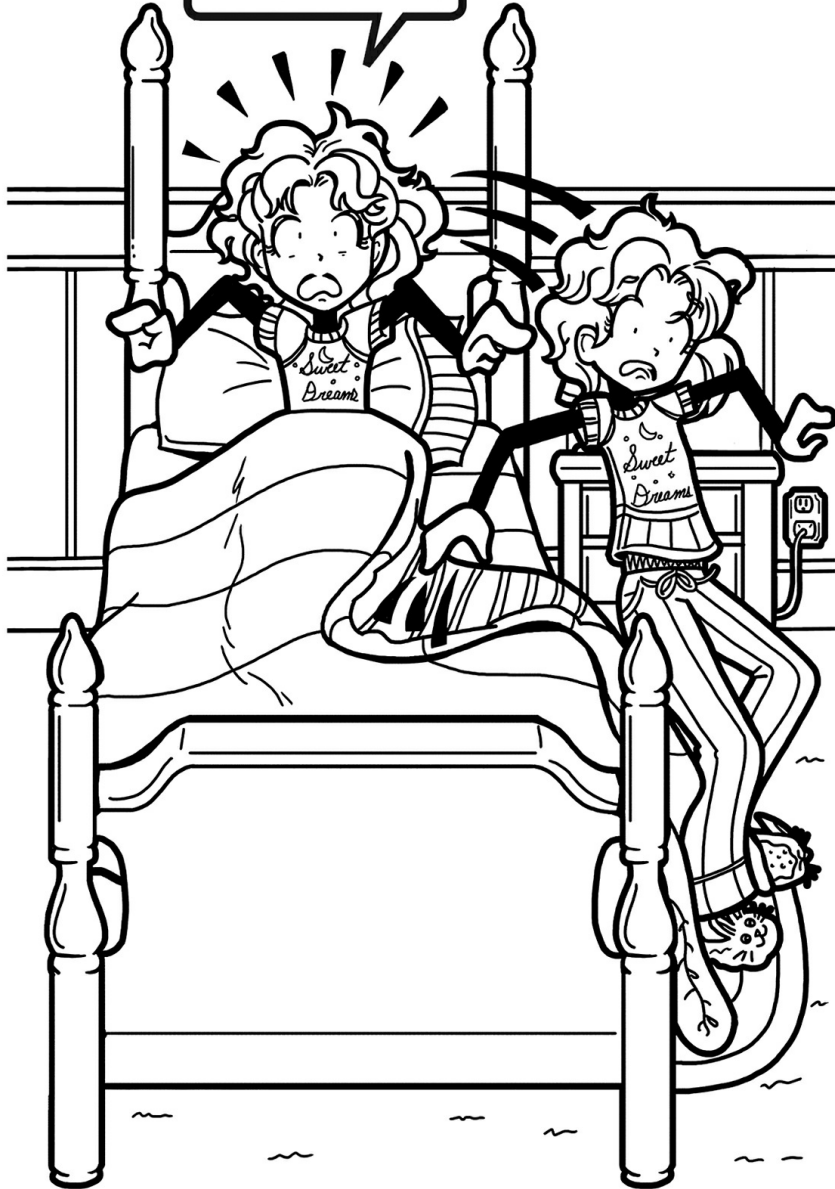

!

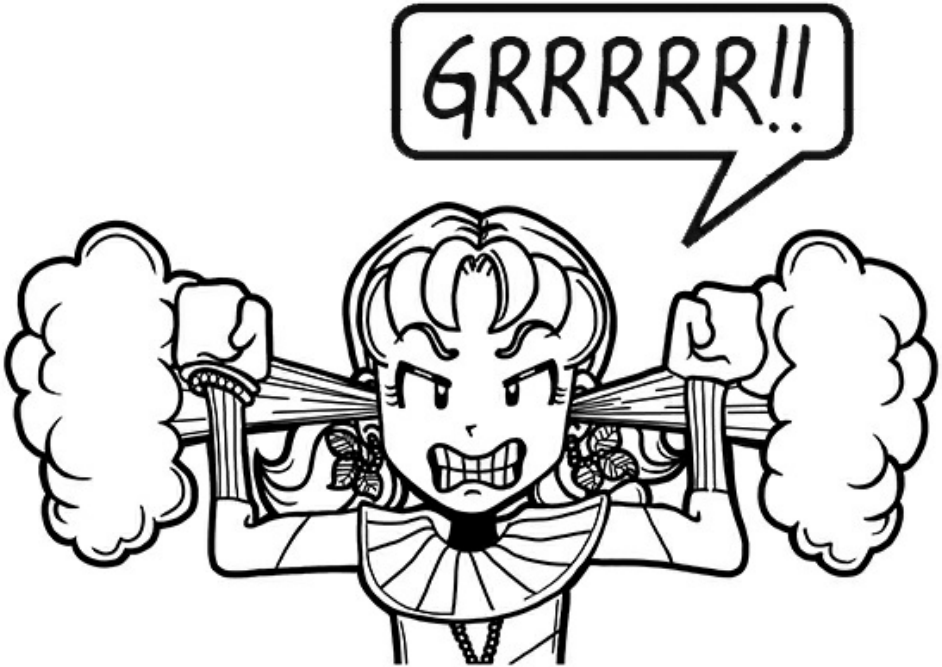
The BAD NEWS . . . ?

"Brianna! Did you take my clock again?!" I yelled. "If I'M late for school, it's all YOUR fault!"

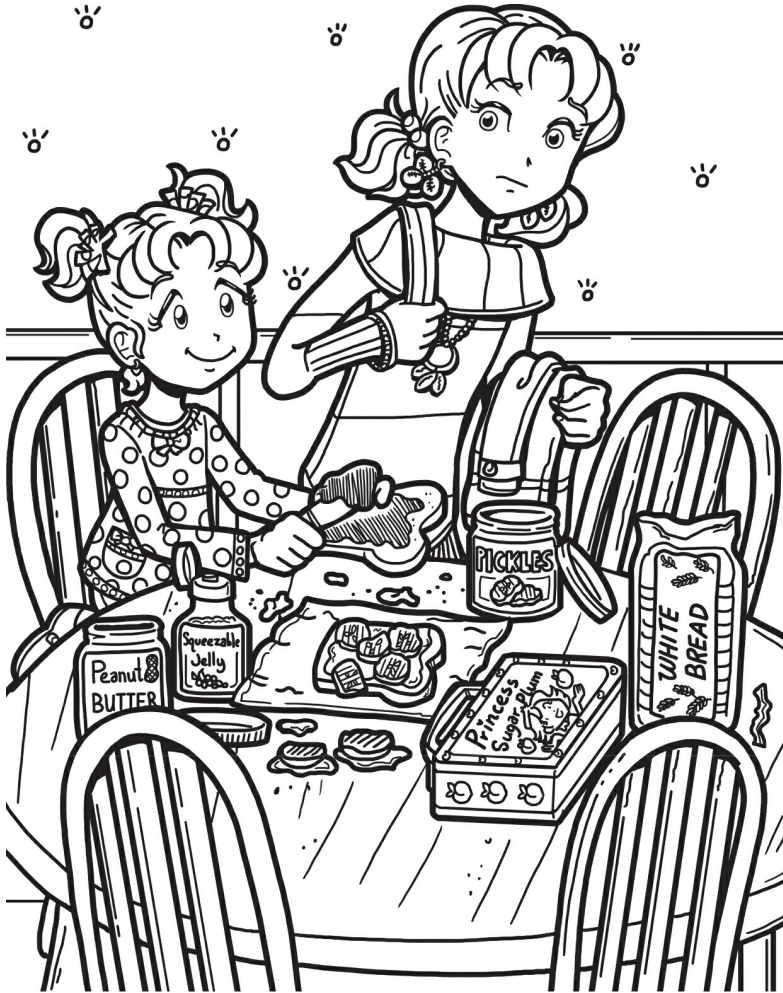

*It made me throw up in my MOUTH!*

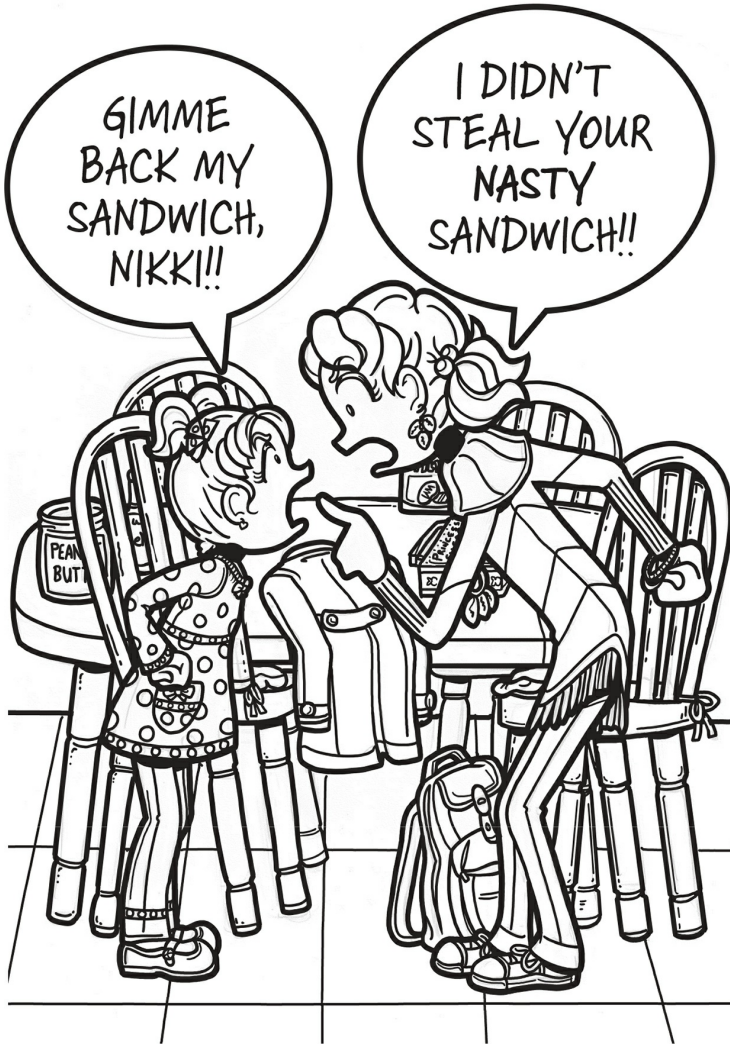
*Call me PICKY! Call me FICKLE!*

WHY?

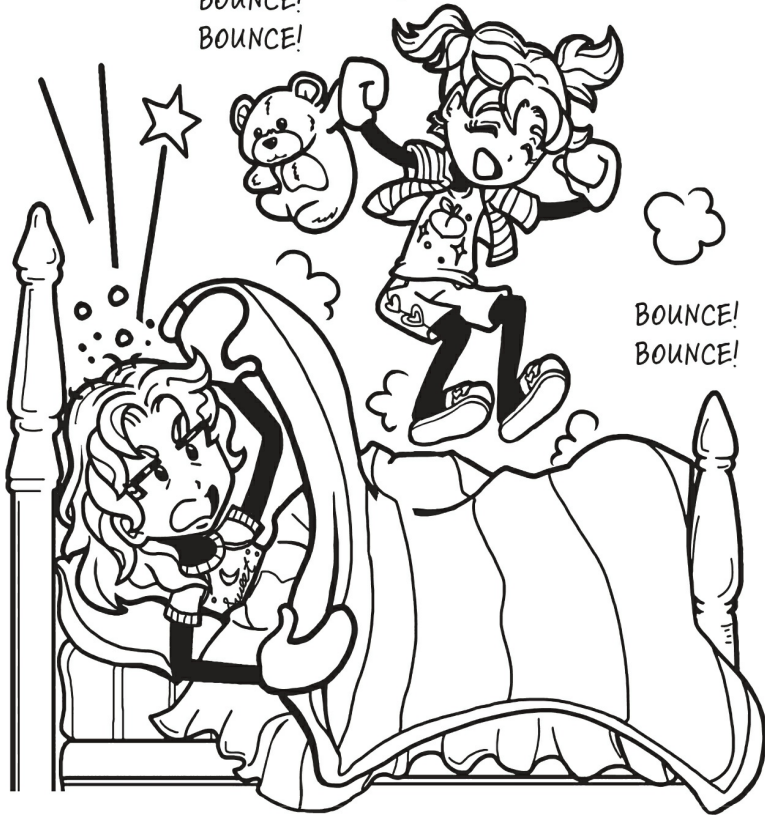
Because I'm really SICK and TIRED of Brianna . . .

And she just couldn't deal with the fact that MY outfit was way CUTTER than HER outfit.

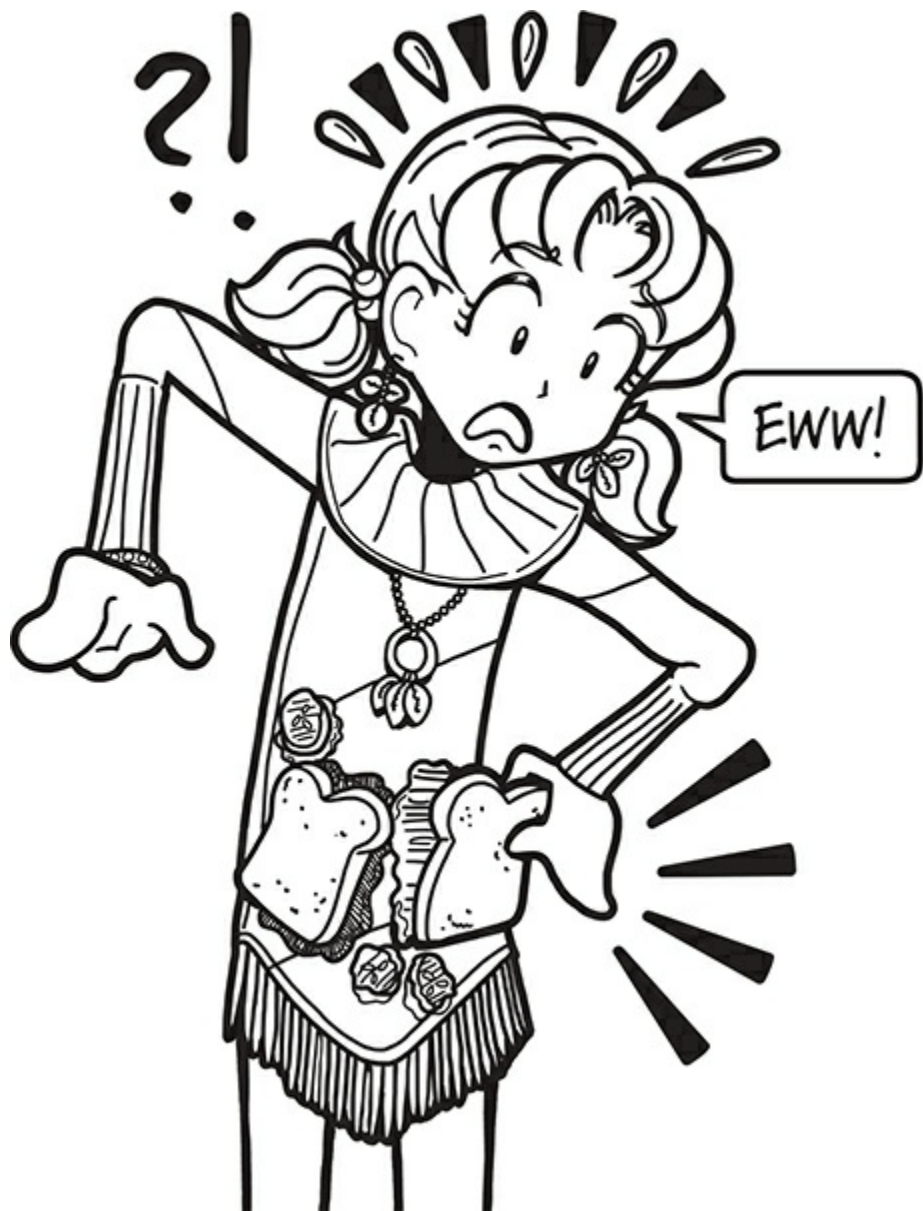
Then she pointed at me and snickered. . . .

1. brown peanut-butter stains

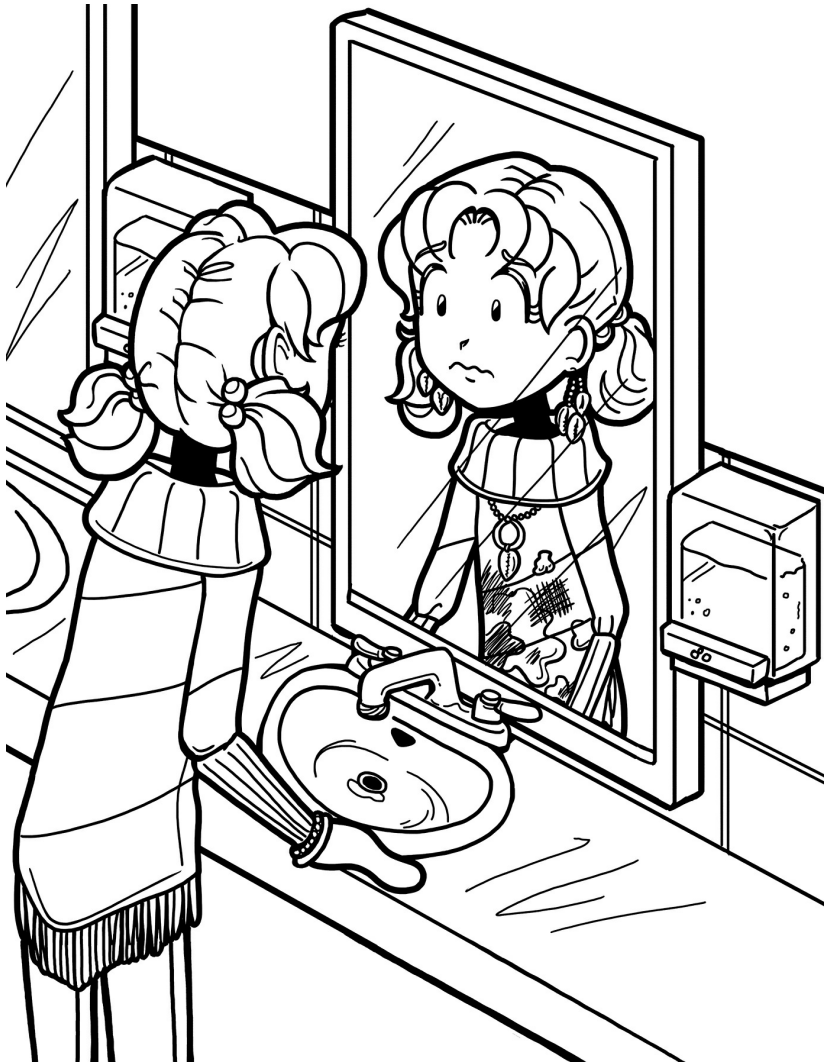
2. purple jelly stains

That meant only one thing! We were going to be doing some type of activity with a ball!

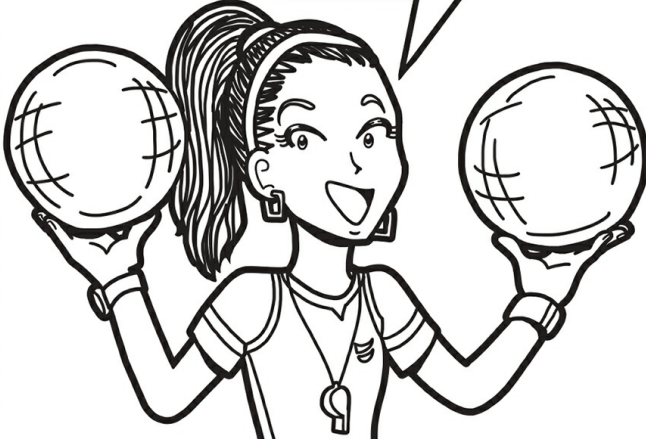
JUST GREAT 😞!

"OMG!" Chloe cried. "I thought Jessica had you for sure!"

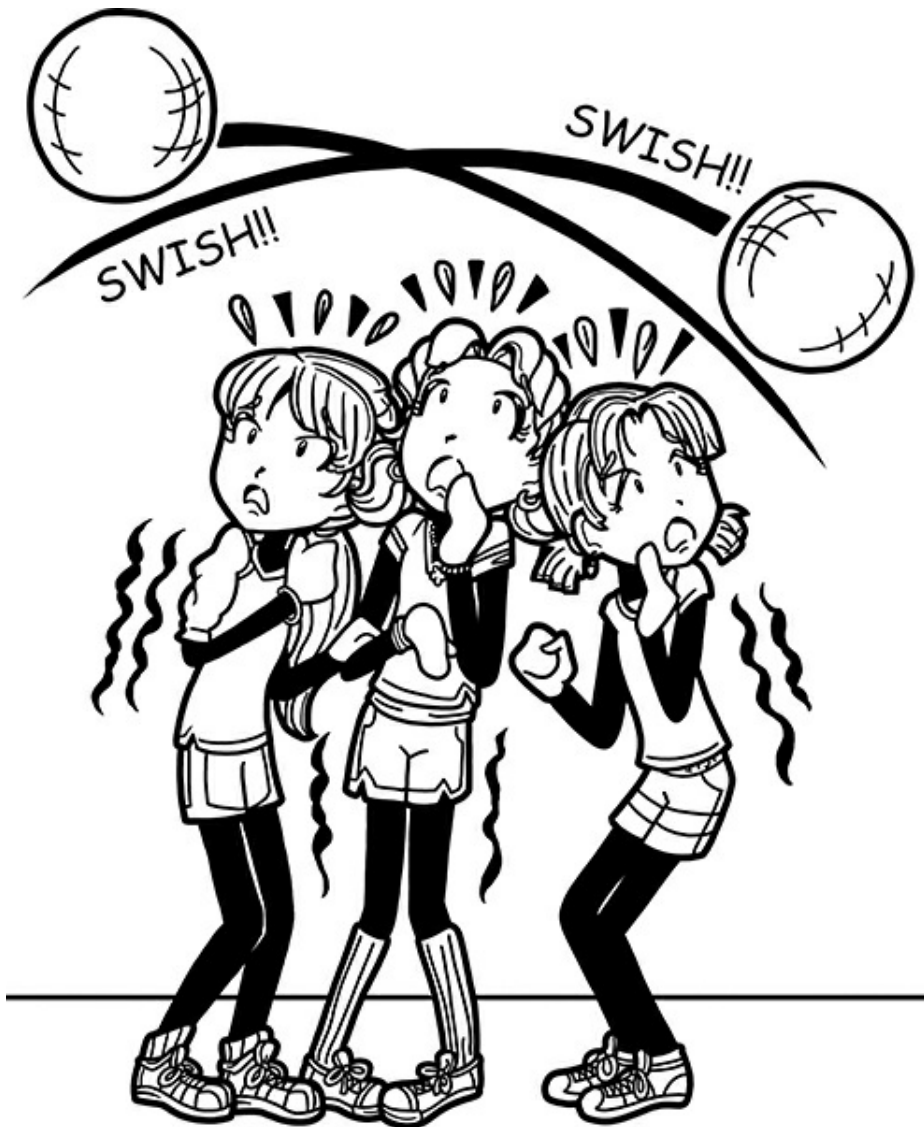
"Nikki, just take deep breaths," Zoey huffed. "You sound like you're hyperventilating!"

That's when we started to really get into the game. We were running, catching, throwing, and dodging like Olympians. It was actually a lot of fun! . . .

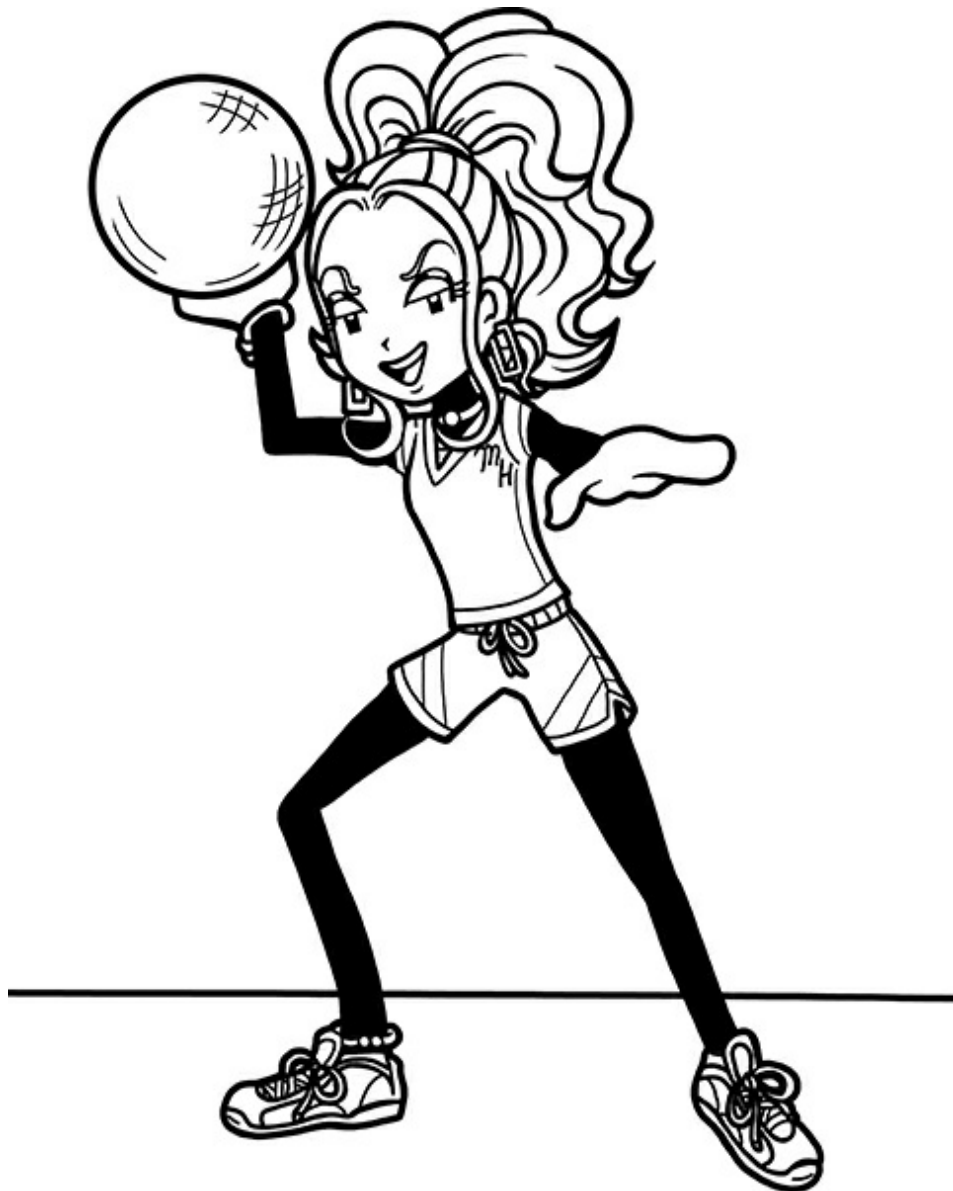

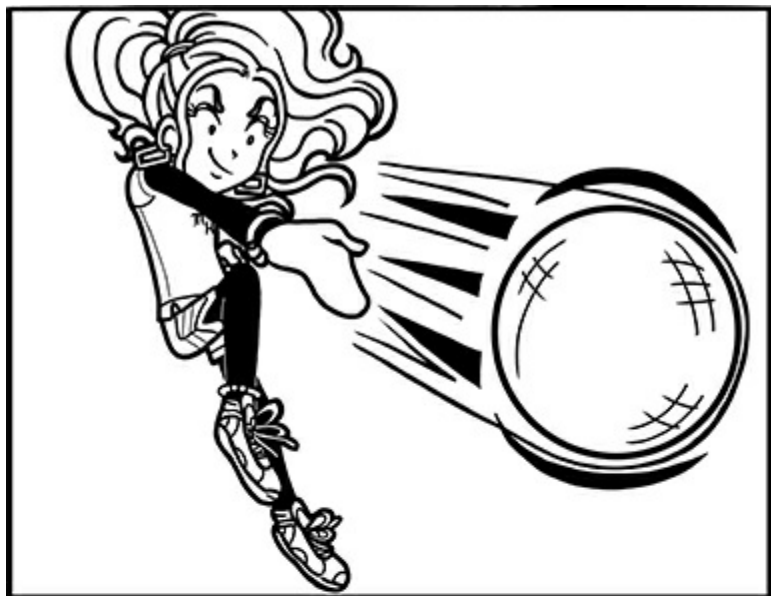


Until MacKenzie suddenly appeared out of nowhere and screamed . . .

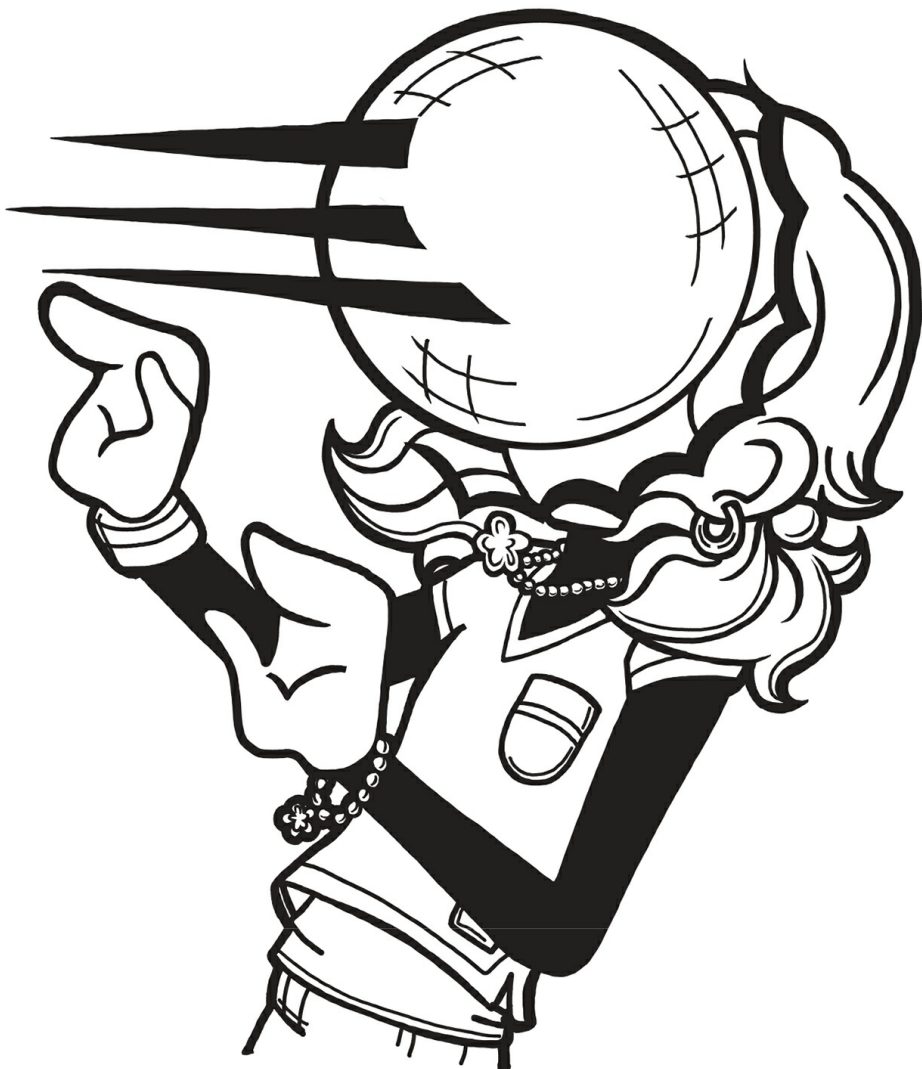


She threw the ball at me as hard as she could! ...

And falling . . .

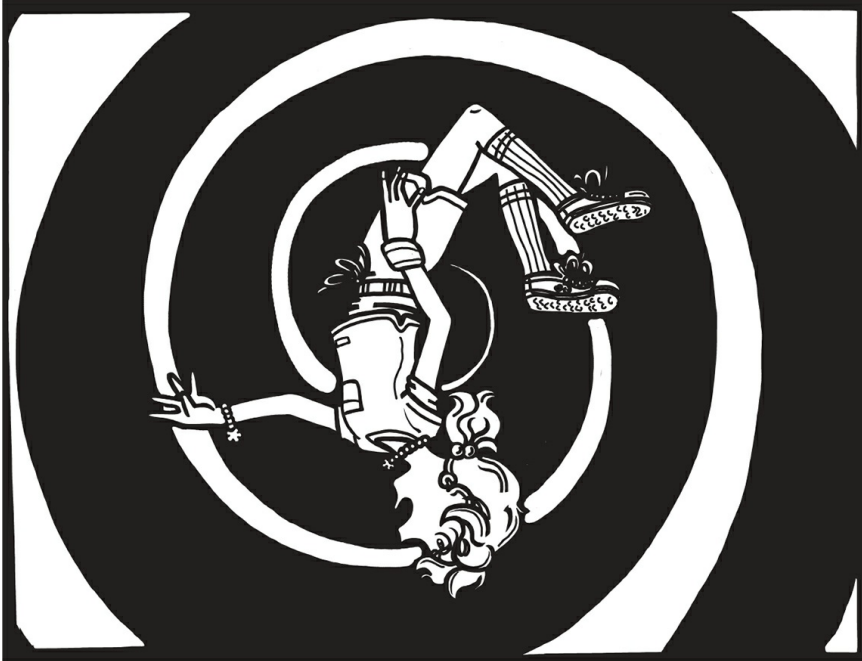
And FALLING 😞!!! . . .

"Here's a pic of the witch bullying us. Those wedgies were pretty brutal. . . ."

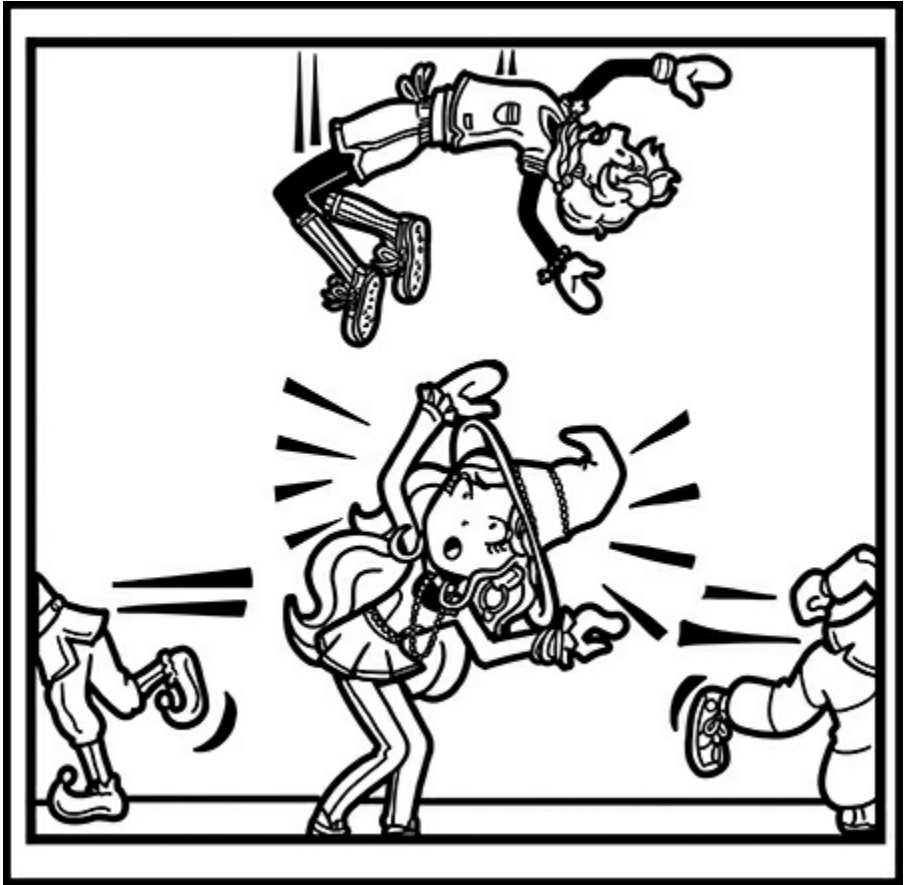

I couldn't believe my eyes!

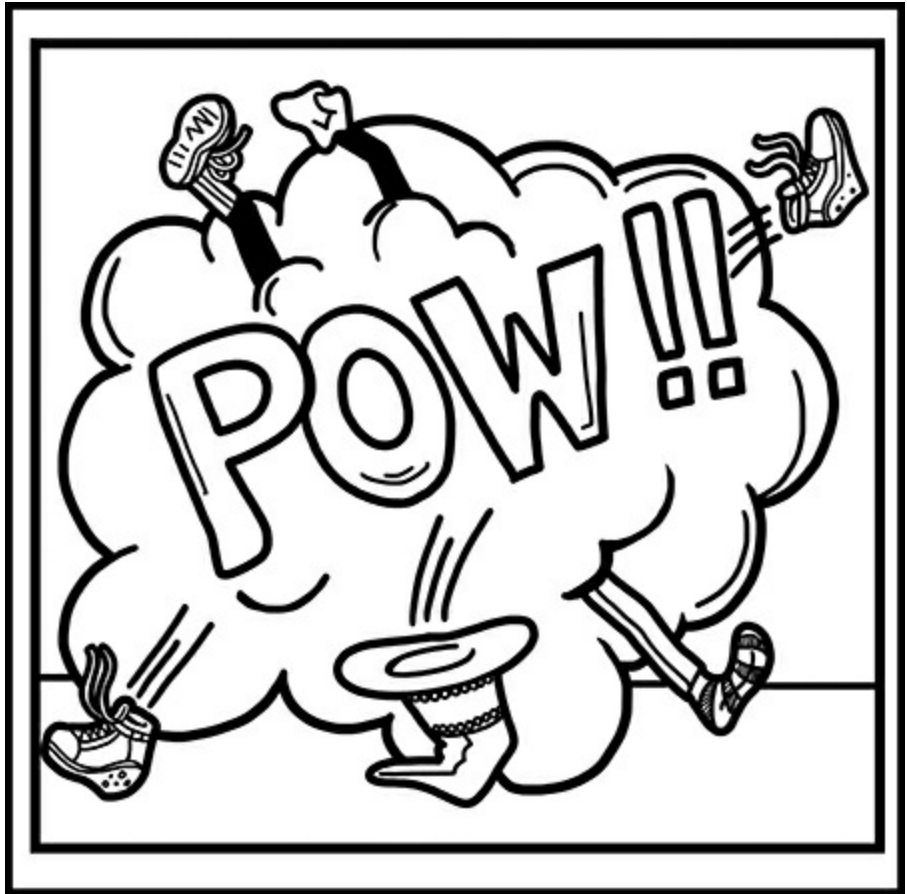
MacKenzie was dressed in a very fashionable witch outfit and torturing two Munchkins with double wedgies! OUCH 😞!!

Maybe she knew the Wizard of Odd. I figured it wouldn't hurt to ask.

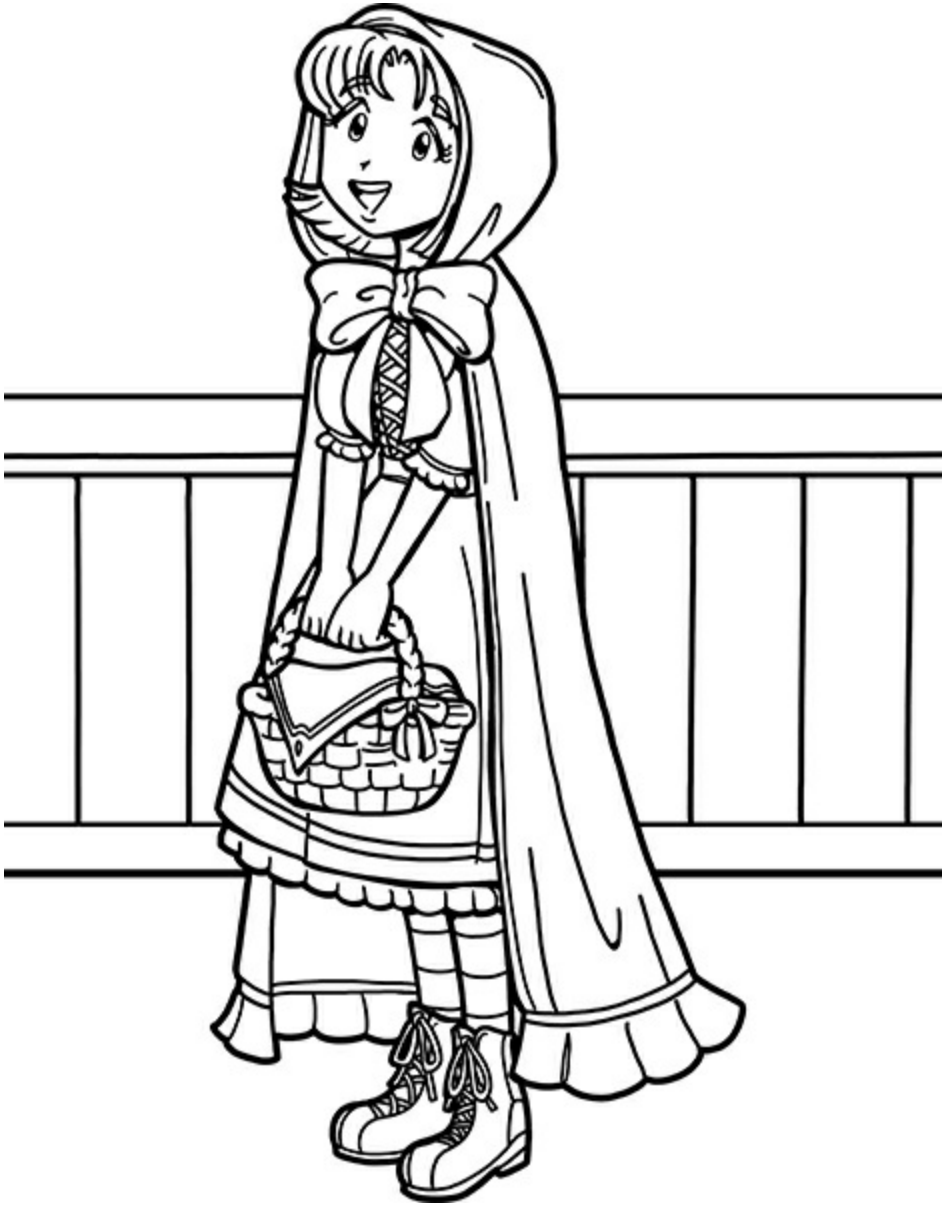
I took off, running after her as fast as I could. But soon she disappeared into a small cottage.

"Grandma, what big EARS you have!"

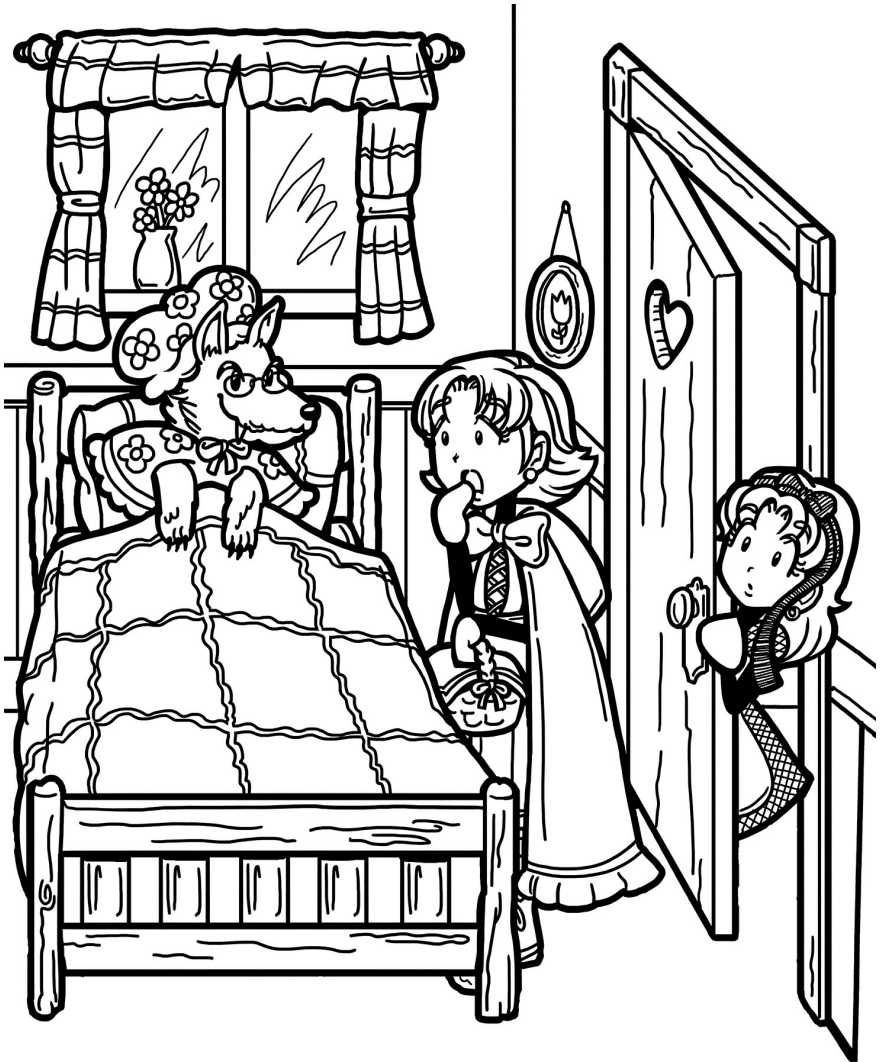
"The better to HEAR you with, my dear."

"The better to EAT you with!! GRRRRR!!!"

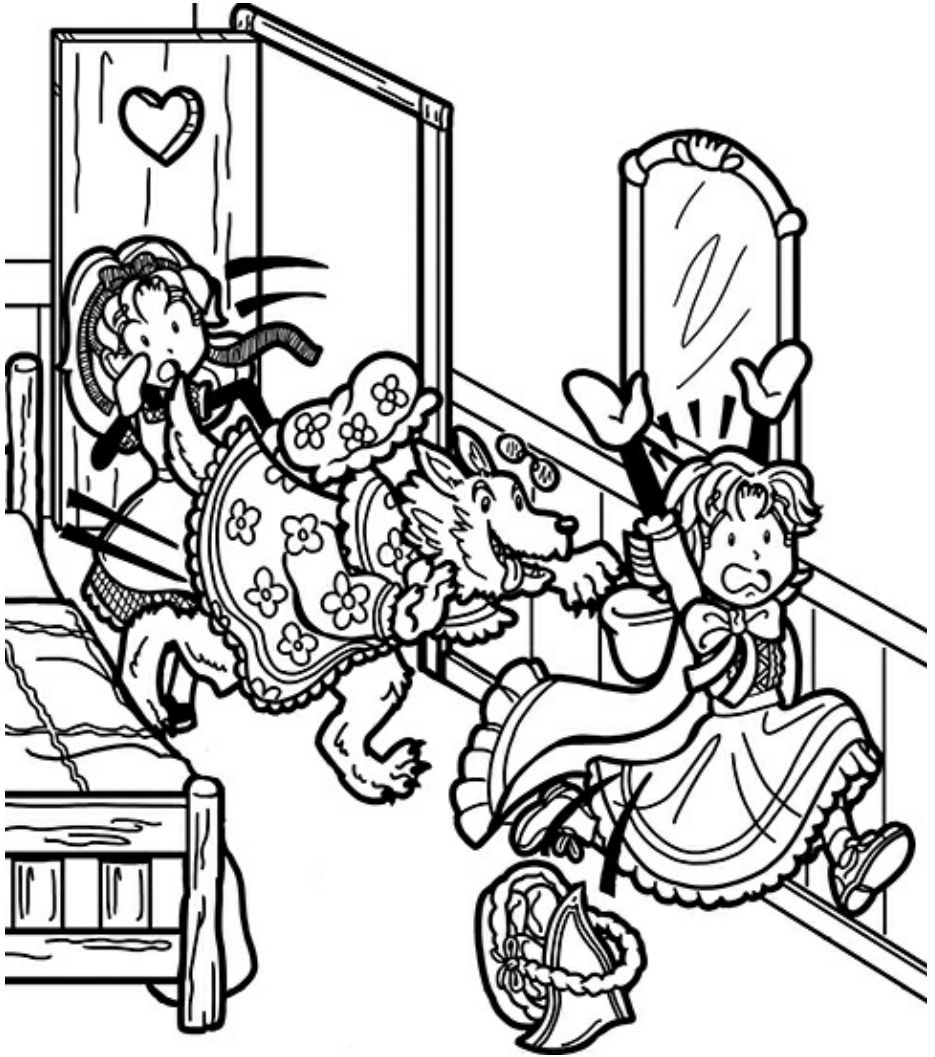
And with that, the wolf leaped across the bed, right at Red Riding Hood.

"Fairy Godmother! Please HELP!" I screamed, praying she would appear. But no luck.

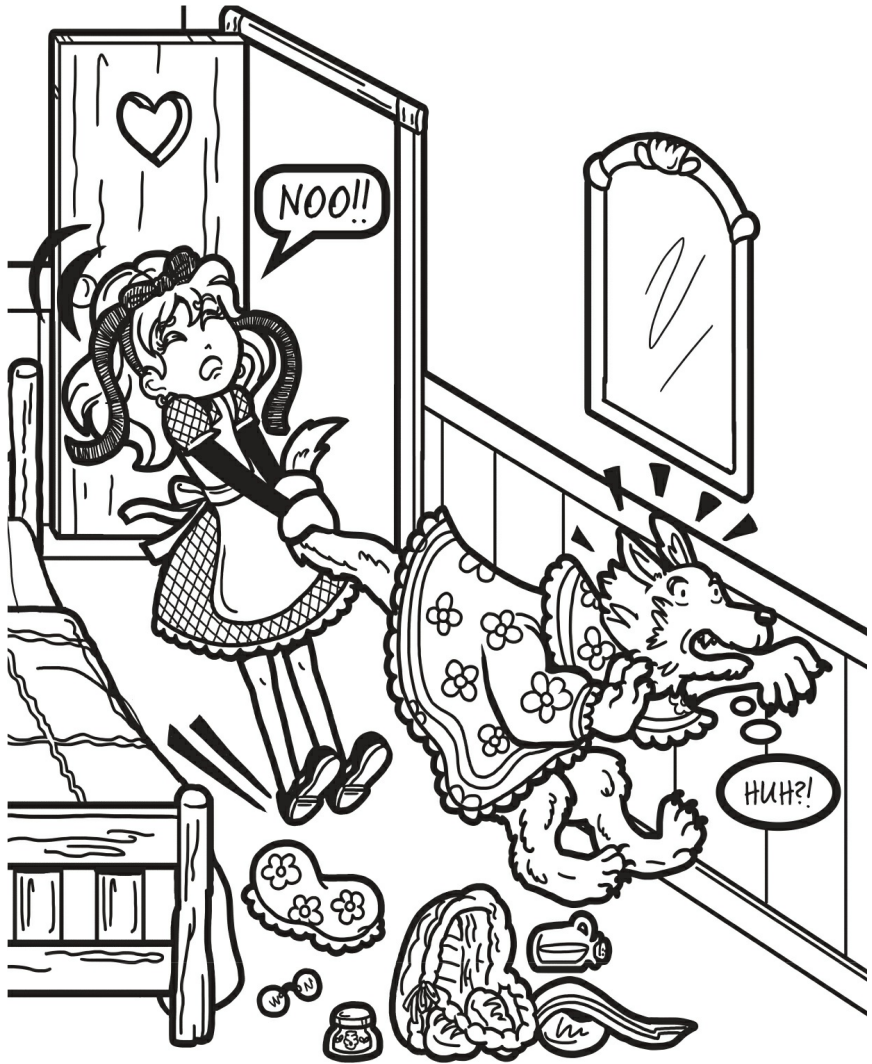
Snarling and gnashing his sharp teeth, that wolf darted right past the door I was hiding behind.

That's when I completely PANICKED and did the first (STUPID) thing that popped into my head. . . .

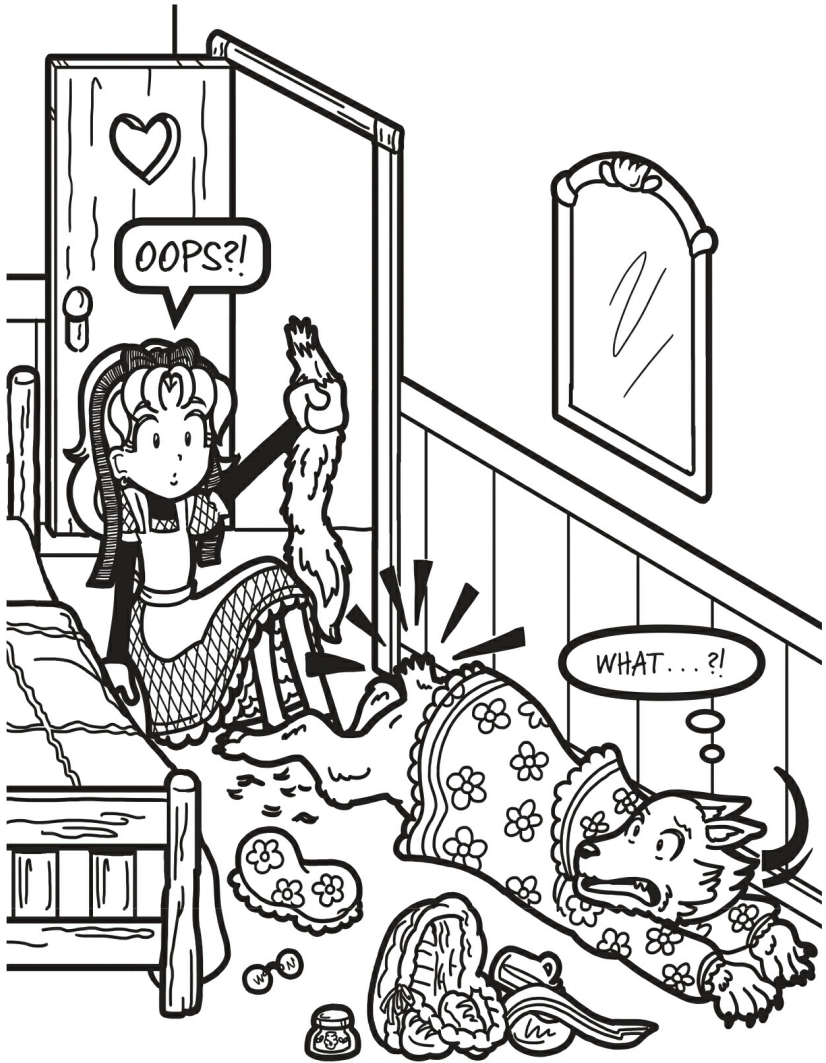

"Okay, and what a FANCY teapot you have!"

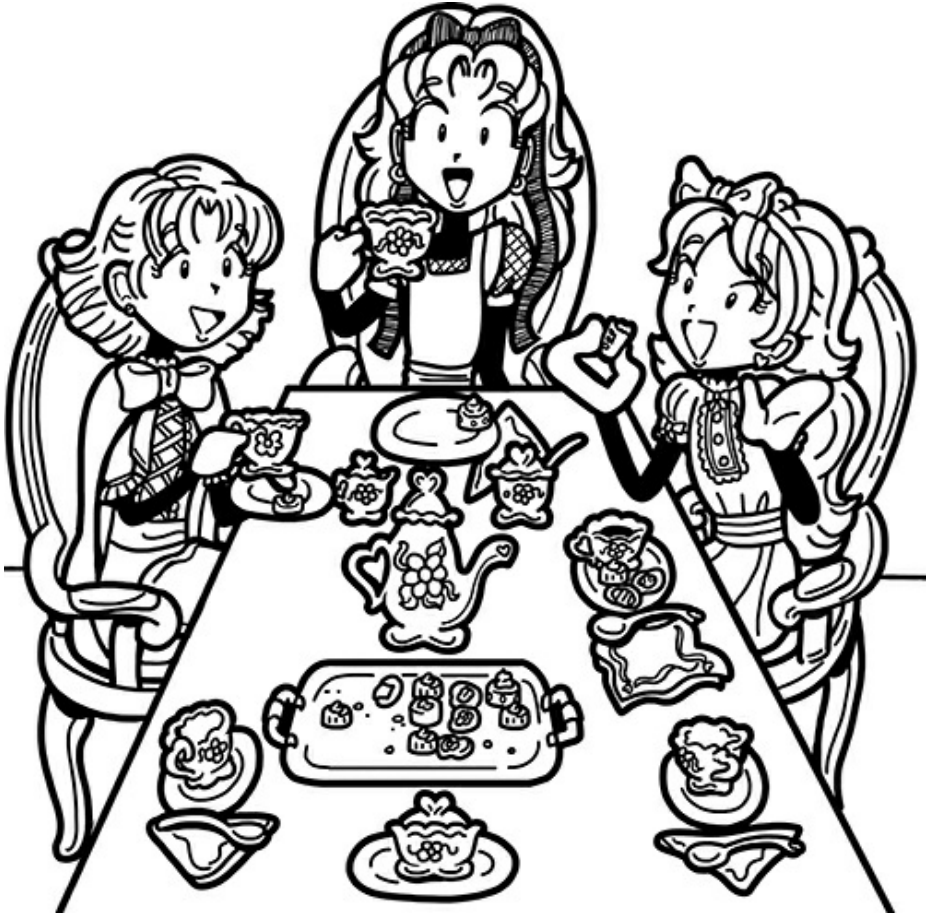
"Thank you! It belonged to my grandmother. I love her dearly. She's as sweet as sugar!"

"Thank you for your comments! I'll have the green tea with extra sugar and the strawberry cheesecake cookies."

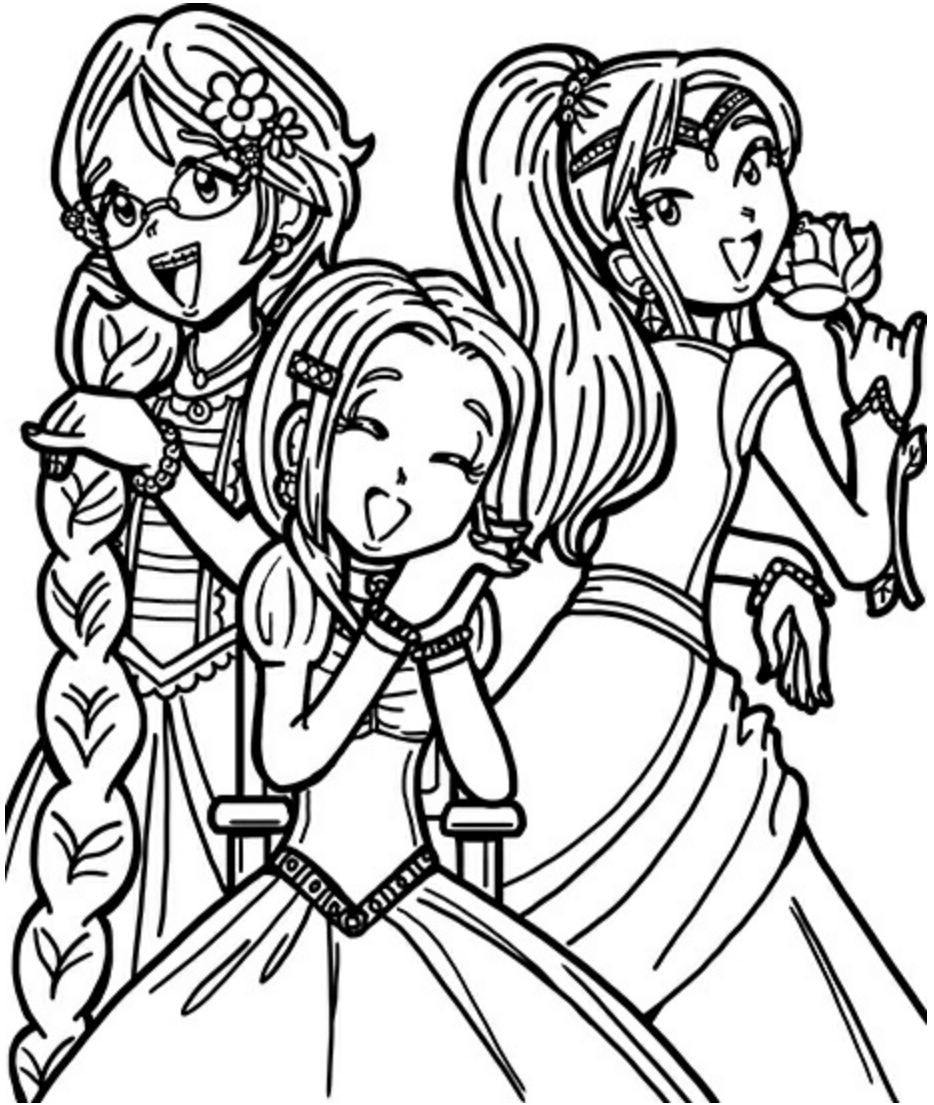
OMG!

They *LOVED* my idea!

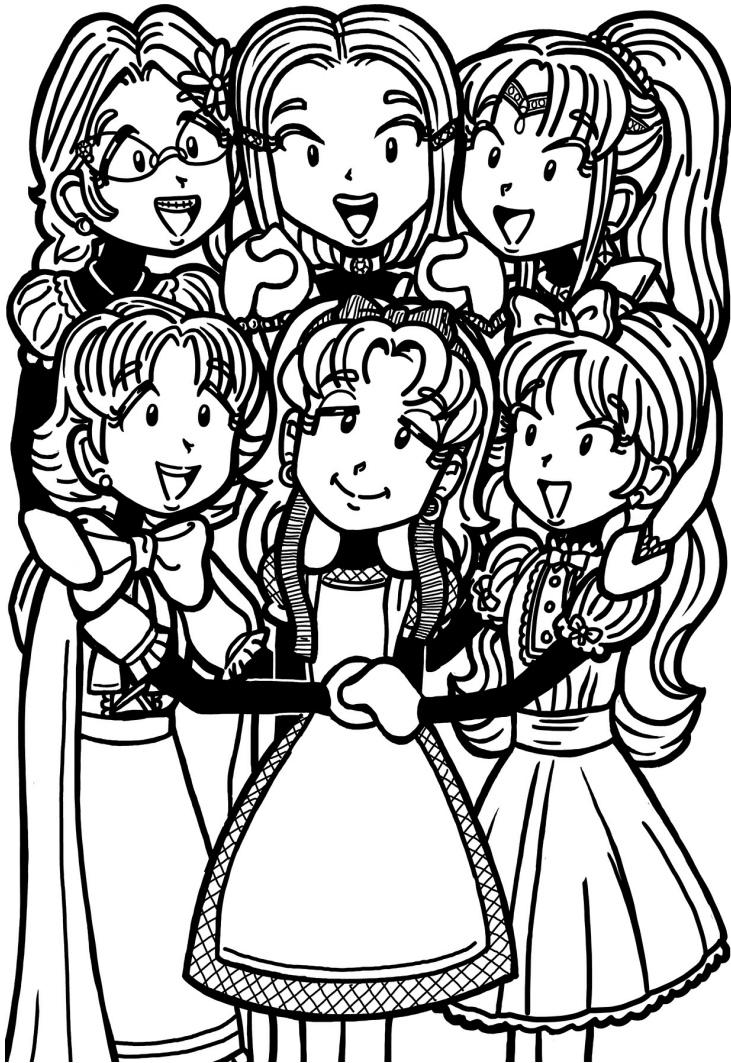

"BRIANNA! Please help! This is an emergency!" I whisper-shouted in desperation.

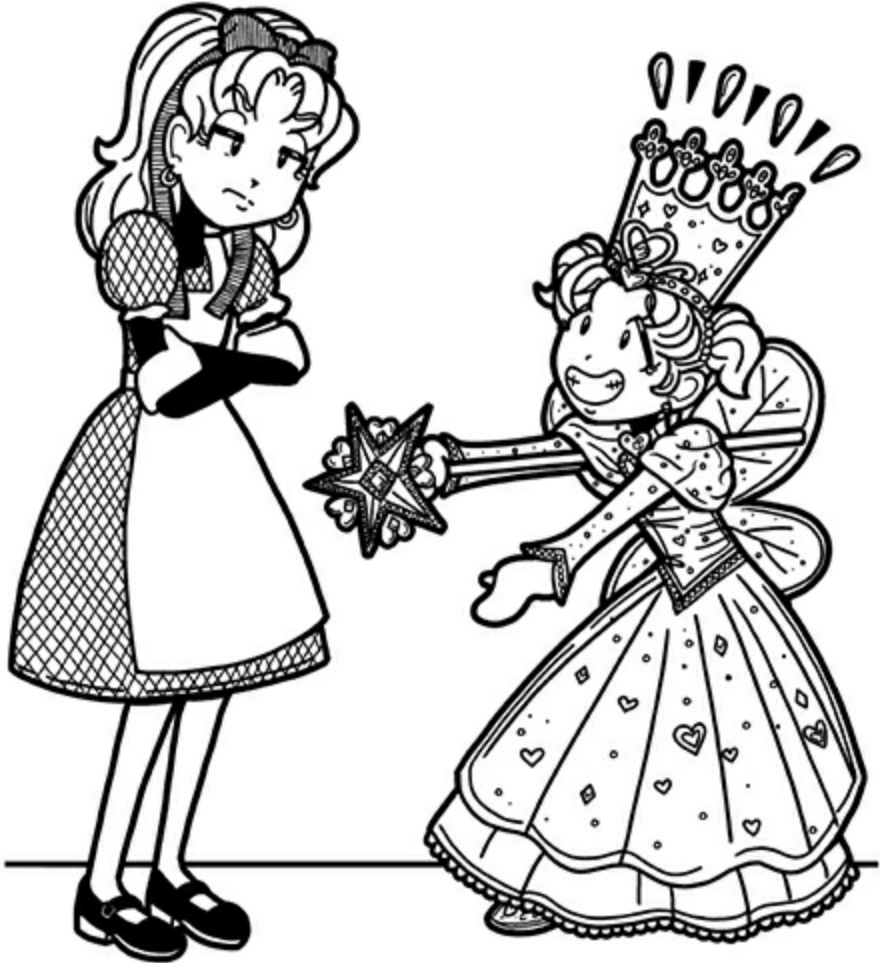
I held my breath and waited. But no Brianna!

"Umm . . . I feel like I should be served on bread with mayo," I said.

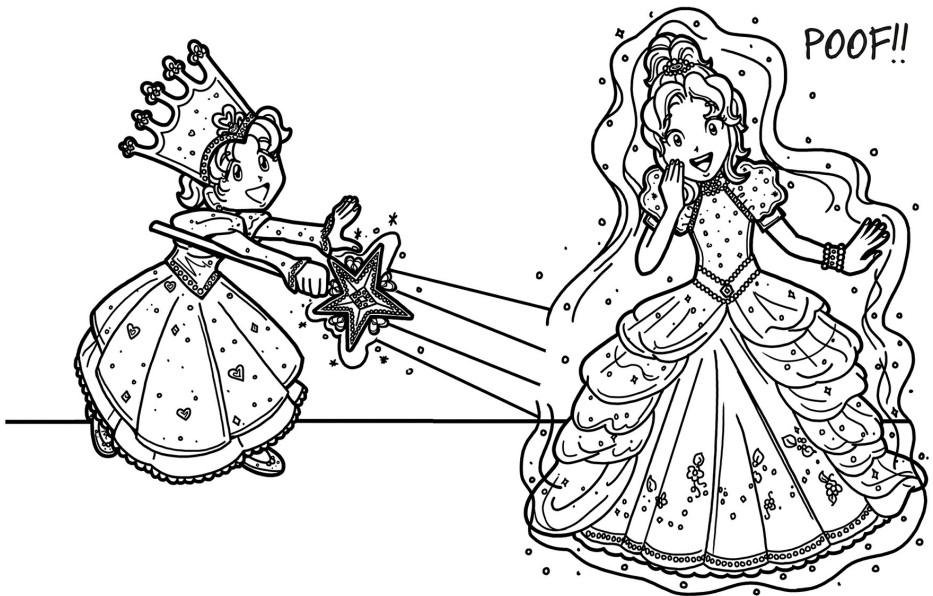
"No, you stupid wand! I said GLAM, not HAM!" Brianna scolded it.

Even though my main goal was to find the Wizard of Odd, the thought of hanging out with royalty was SUPERexciting.

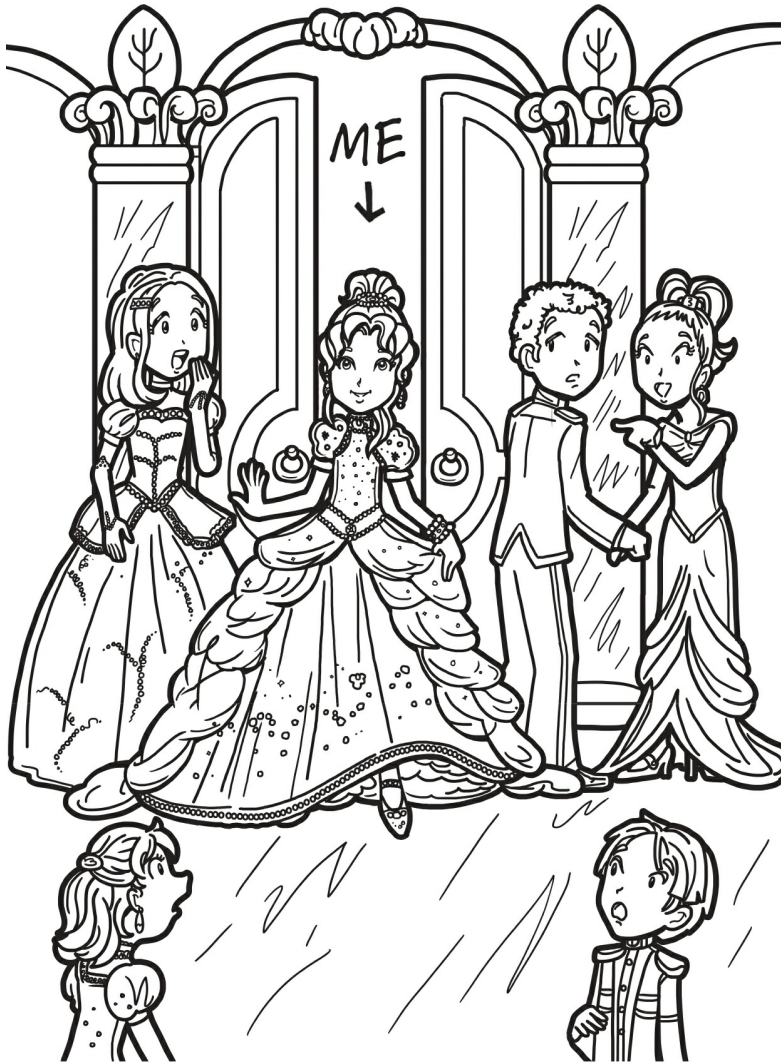
As I approached the main entrance, all the guards snapped to attention.

That's when he smiled and stared at me, and I smiled and stared back at him.

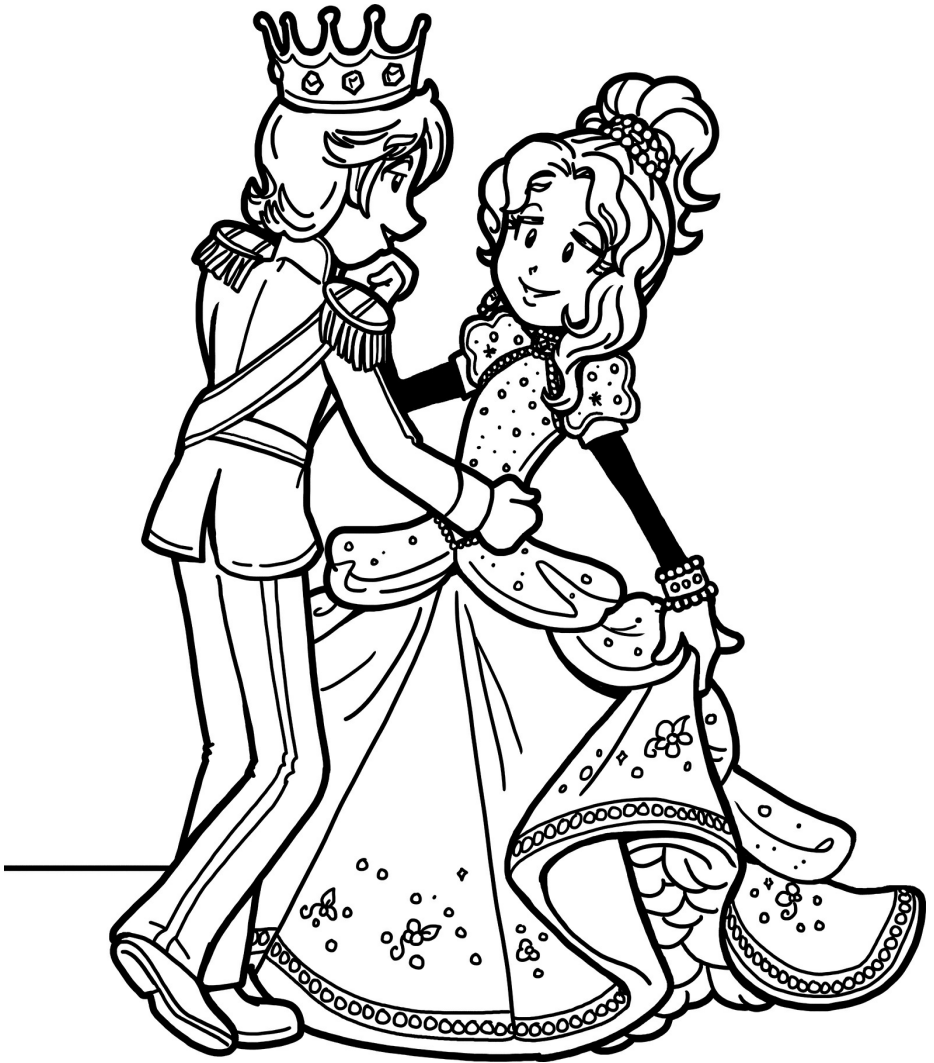
All of this smiling and staring went on for what seemed like FOREVER!

I still feel pretty awful about ditching Prince Brandon at the ball. He's such a nice guy.

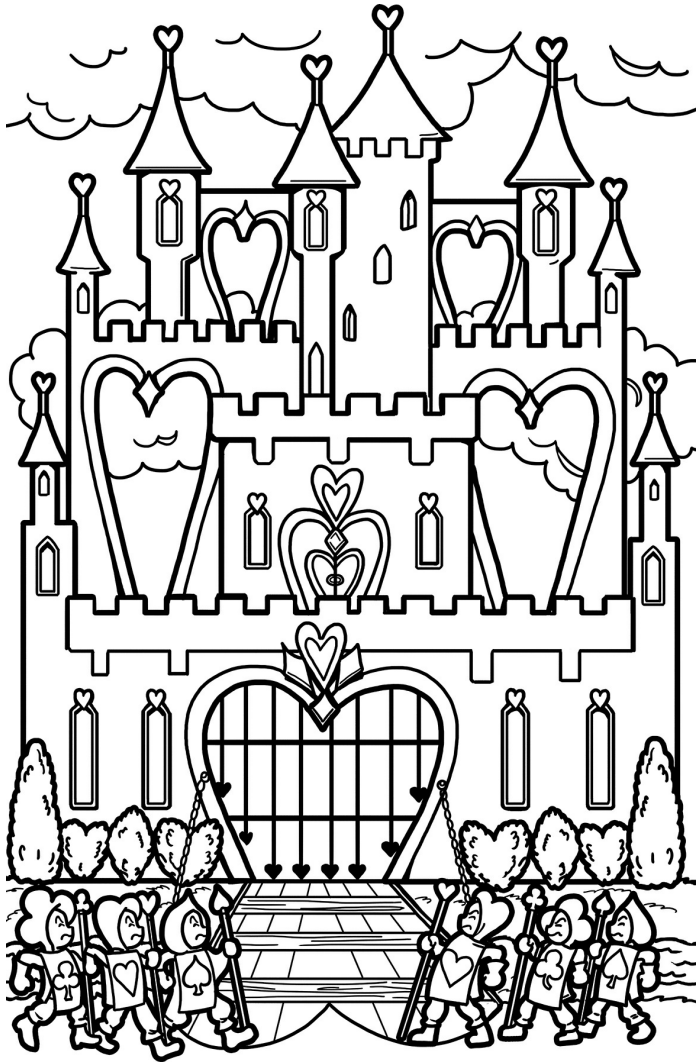
But the perfect girl for him is out there somewhere. And I'm pretty sure she isn't ME.

"SILENCE!!!!!!!" the queen yelled.

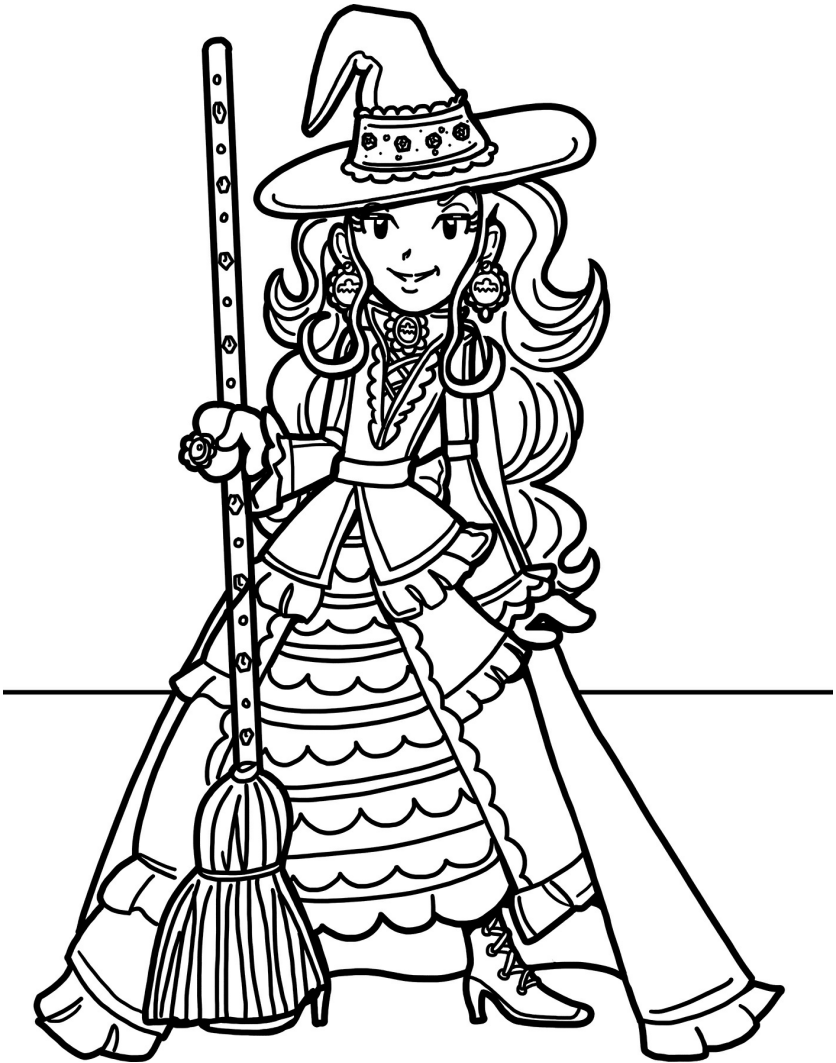
"Yes, d-dear. Where are my manners?" the king stammered nervously. "Why don't I go get you a drink of cold punch, sweetheart?"

"But that's NOT fair!" I yelled. "Nobody told me I was going to be executed after my trial even if I was found innocent!"

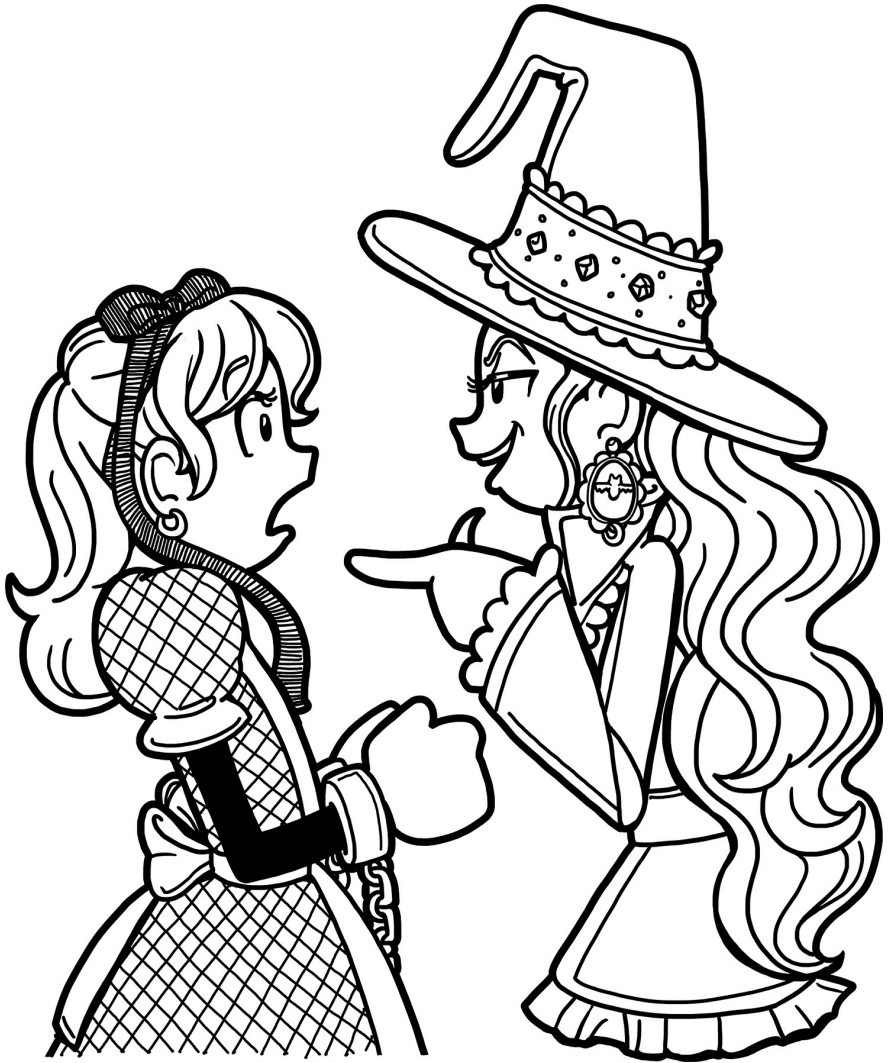
"What do you mean? I just told you a couple of seconds ago!" Sir Hawk said, looking at me like I had the IQ of belly button lint

MacKenzie was smiling insanely and waving good-bye to me.

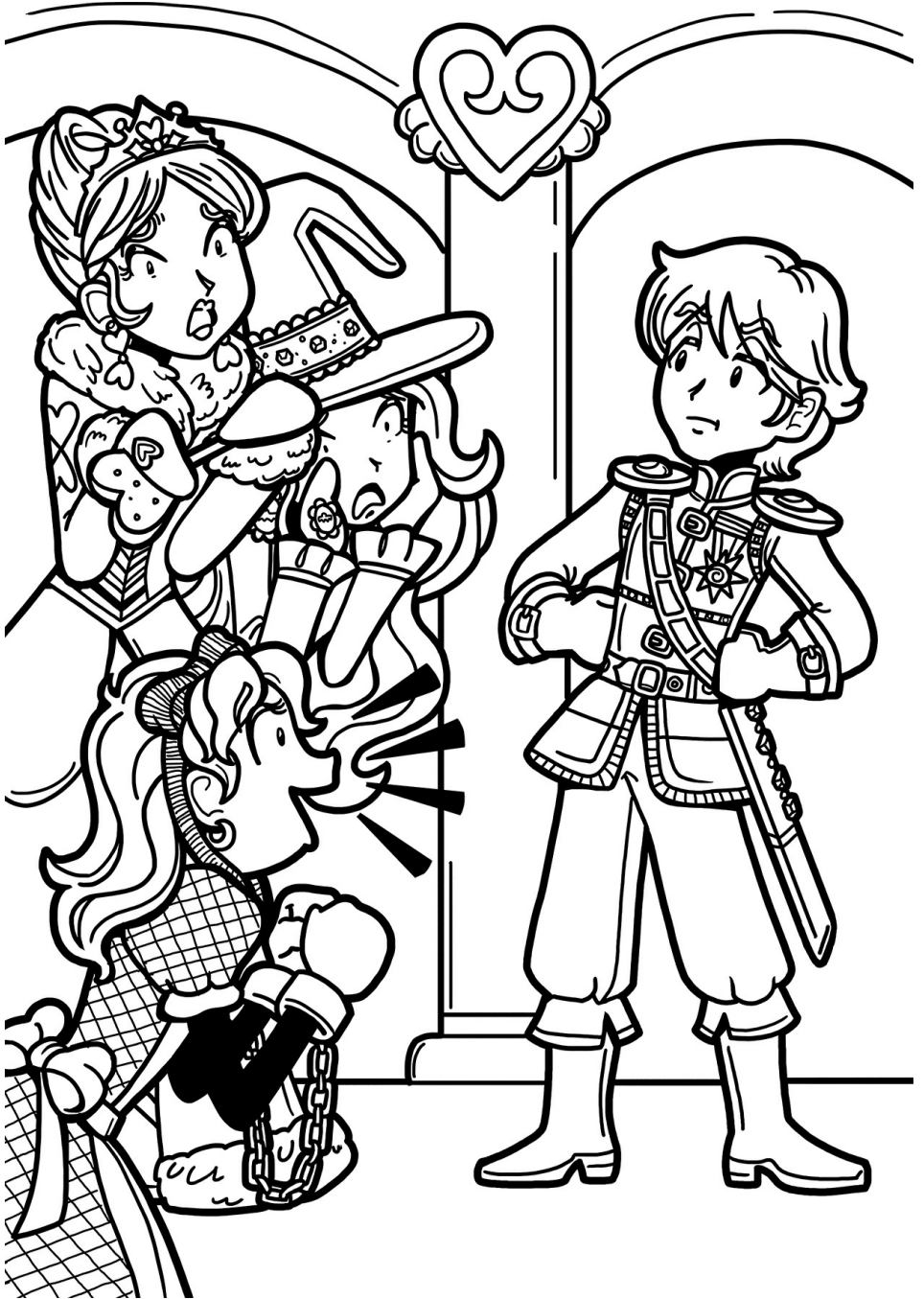
"Now, dear! Aren't we being a bit hasty?" the king sputtered. "Surely there are witnesses who actually know what really—"

I didn't want to admit it, but I was feeling a little jealous of whoever this new princess was.

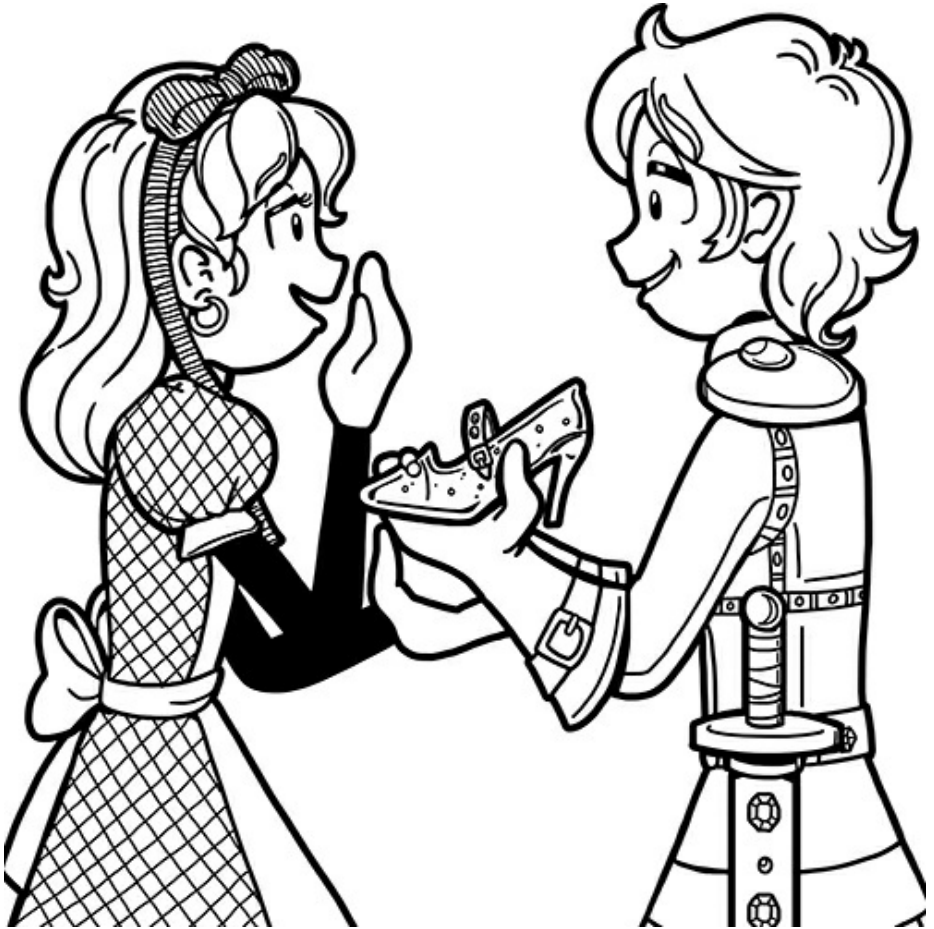
In spite of the time we had spent together at the ball, apparently he had already moved on to someone else.

Everyone laughed at my silly joke. But I think Prince Brandon and I laughed the hardest.

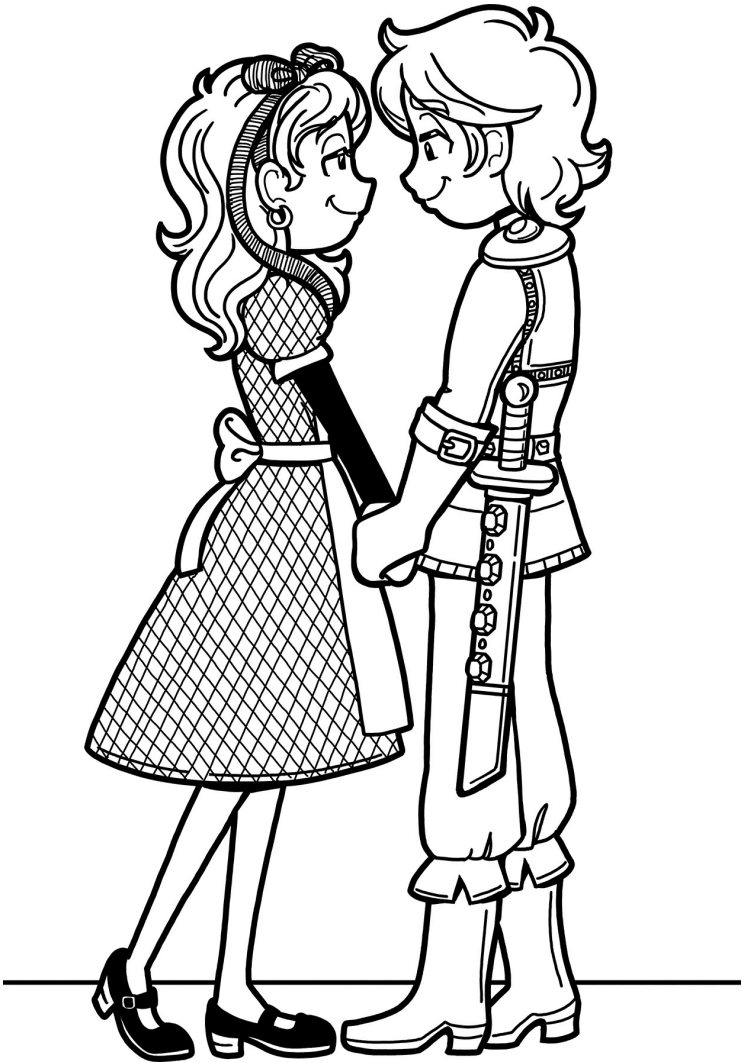
It was amazing to see that the Renegades and the Regals had taken my advice. They were not only actively pursuing their dreams, but good friends.

"Okay, Nikki! Stand right here!" she instructed.

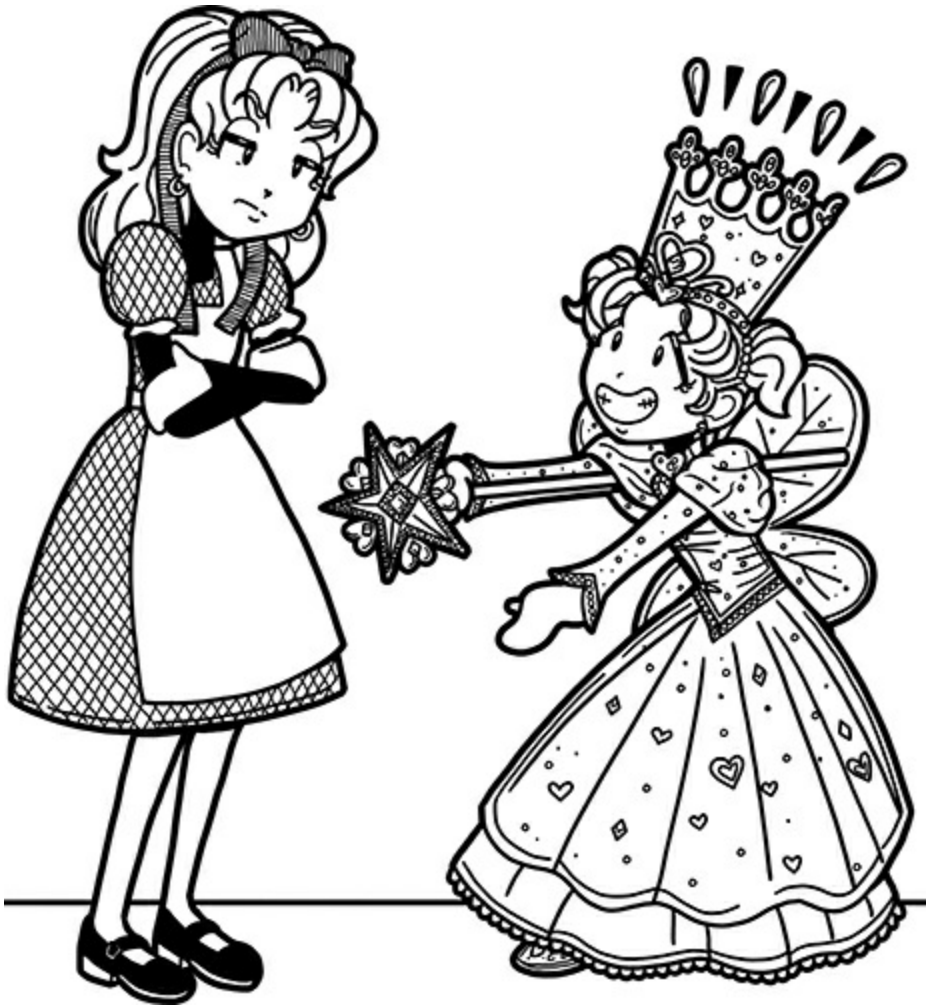
*"Magic potion, lucky charm!"*

Unfortunately, my FACE was in the wrong place at the wrong time. AGAIN! . . .

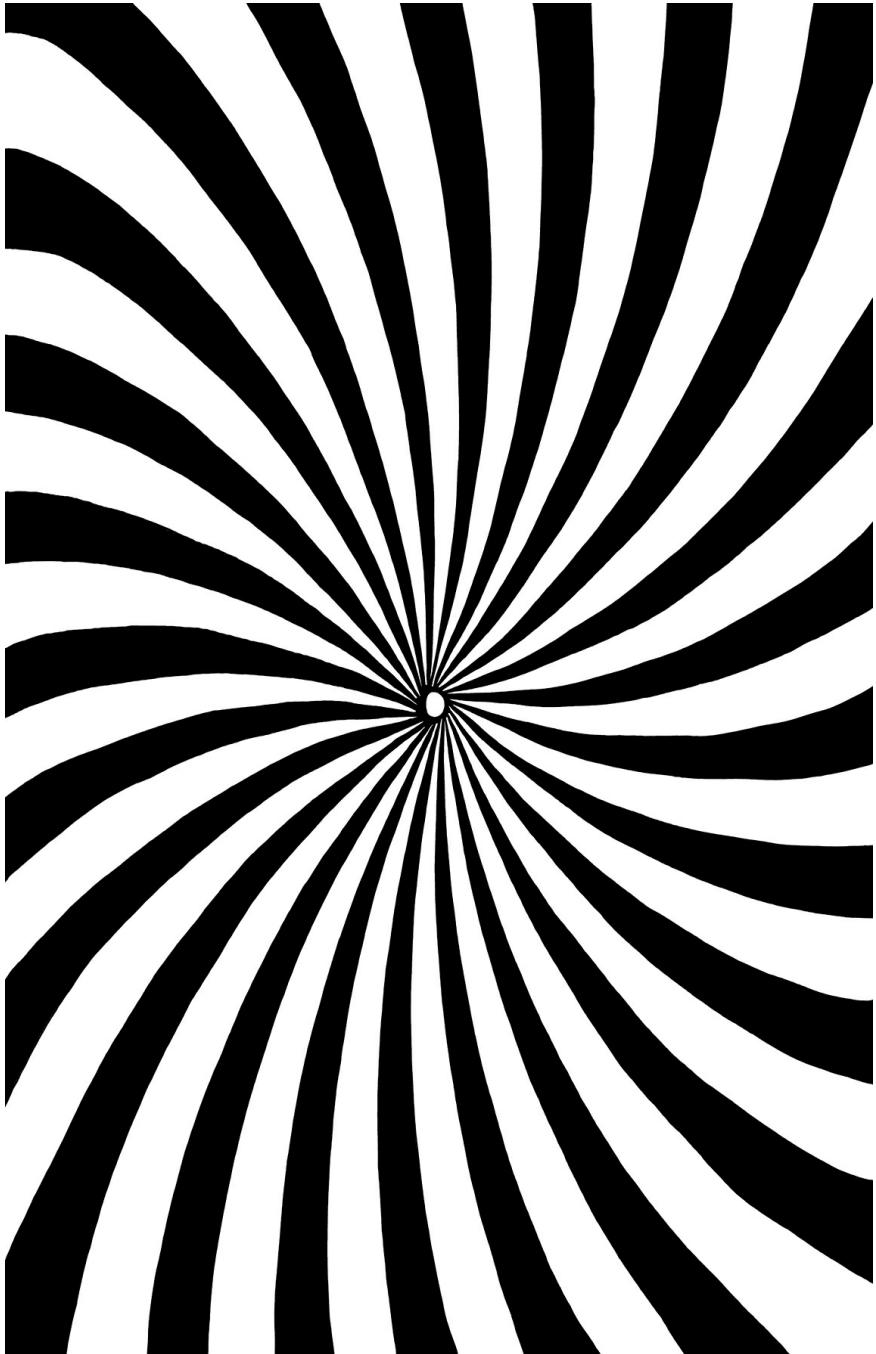
WHAM!!

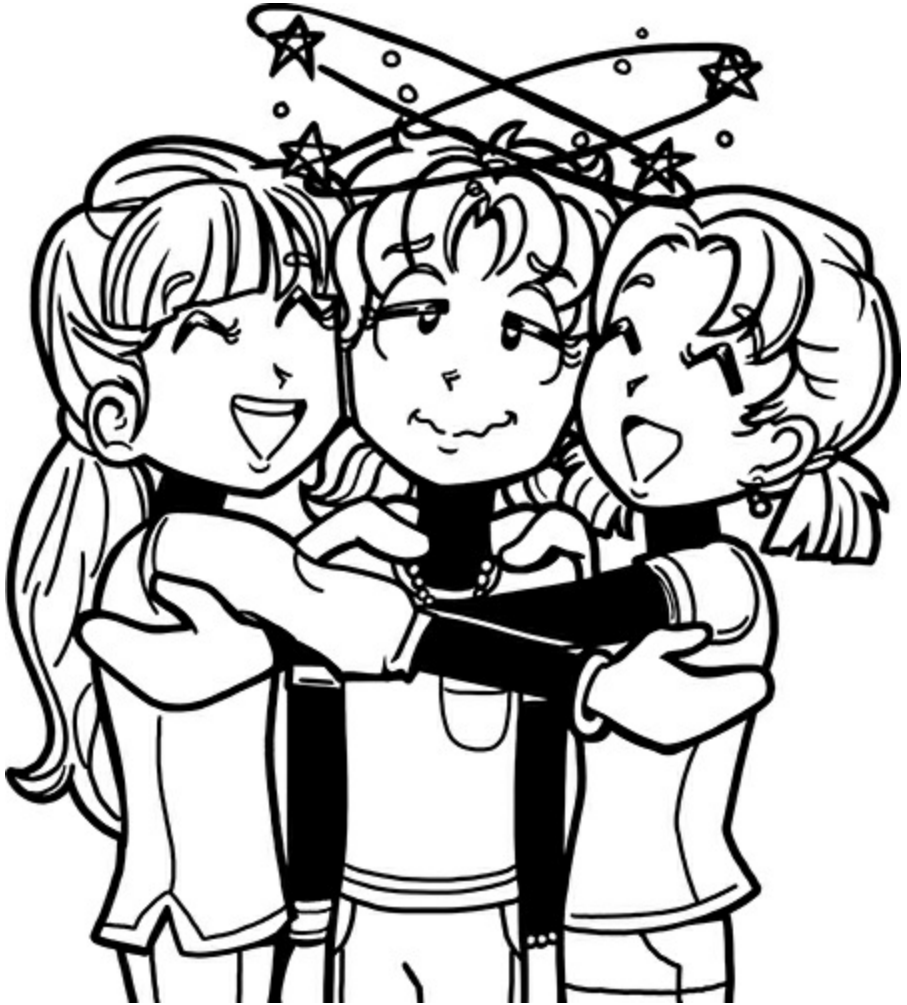
Chloe and Zoey each grabbed an arm and helped me stand up.

After we got dressed, Chloe and Zoey walked me to my locker.

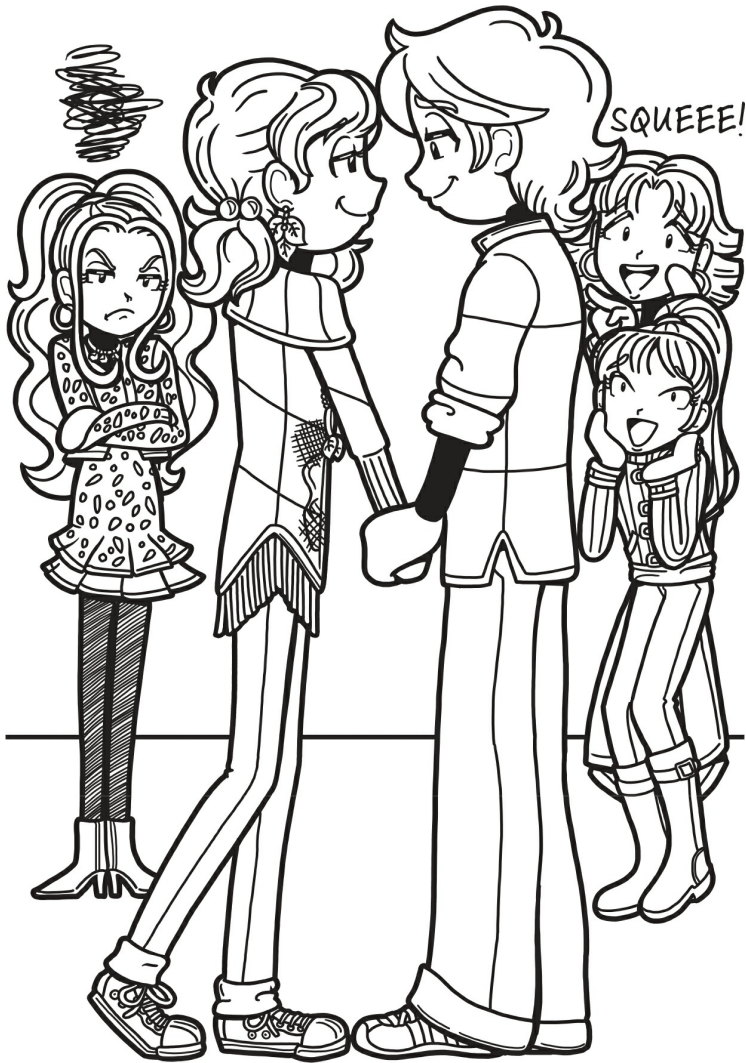
Then we headed for the nurse's office.

After my fairy tale FIASCO, I was mentally and physically exhausted.

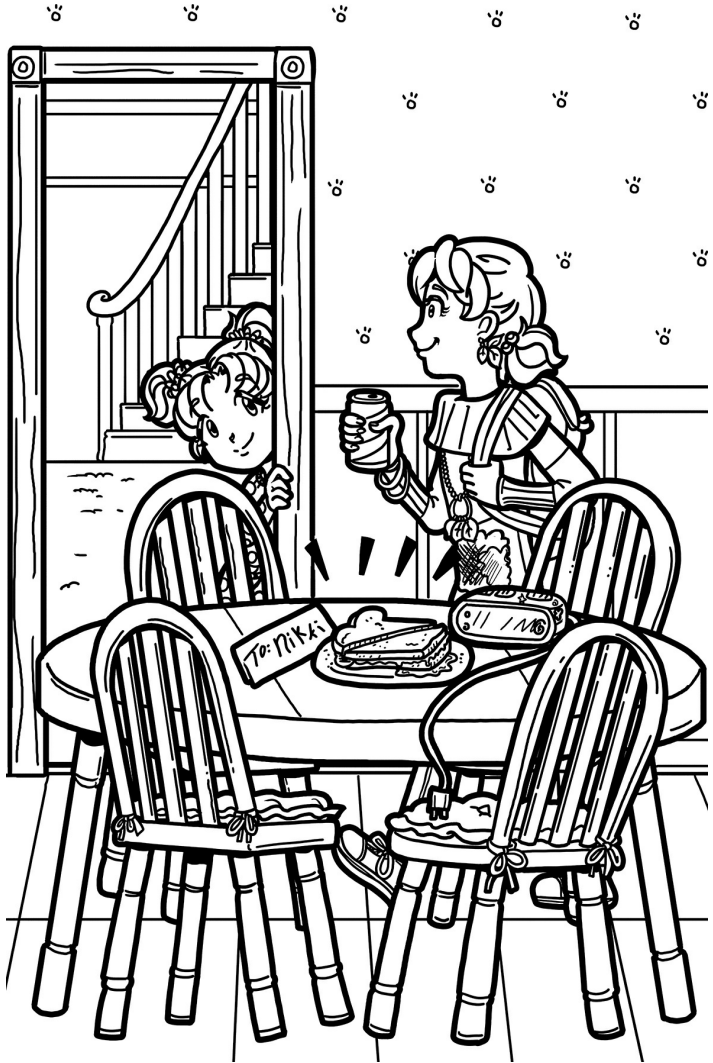
