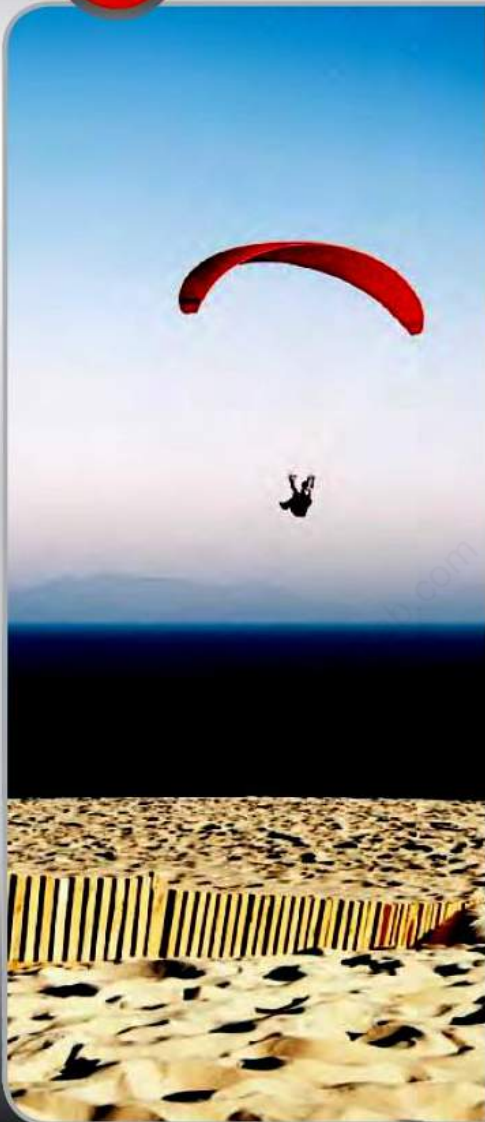



What happened three days ago?

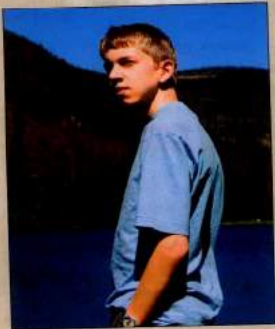

FAMOUS STADIUMS

Prince Abdullah Al-Faisal Stadium



Prince Abdullah Al-Faisal Stadium opened in 1970 in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. The stadium is part of a large sports complex, which includes a water sports area, with seats for 20,000 people. Prince Abdullah Al-Faisal Stadium is famous because many important games take place there, with millions of sports fans watching them.

Camp Nou

The Camp Nou Stadium is the home of FC Barcelona, a Spanish football team. They started building it in 1954 and finished in 1957. In the 1982 World Cup, Spain used Camp Nou for many important games and for the opening ceremony. Today, 98,722 people can fit into the stadium and it is usually full, especially for *El Clásico* matches when Barcelona play Real Madrid.
