Below are some other suffixes you can buy that are used around the world.

Domain Suffix	Meaning
.com	for commercial websites - most businesses prefer a .com domain name because it is a highly recognised symbol for having a business presence on the internet
.org	for organisations - usually charity and non-profit groups
.tv	for television stations
.mobi	for websites designed for mobile phones
.me	for personal websites, like your family photos
.info	for information sources
.travel	for travel related websites

There are some website suffixes that you cannot purchase. They are only available to approved organisations, such as schools. See below:

Domain Suffix	Limited to
.gov	for United States government websites; local government agencies are able to use this combined with their country code, for example, .gov.ae is used for the UAE government
.edu/.ac	for higher educational institutions
.mil	for the United States military
