They are diseases that directly passed from one person to another.

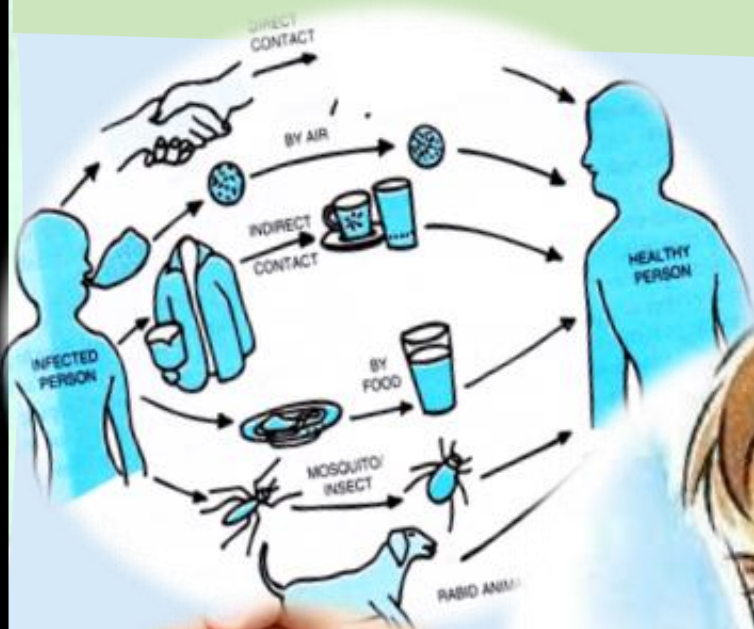
Examples for communicable diseases:
