# GRAMMAR WORKSHEET EITHER ... (OR) / NEITHER ... (NOR)

#### **Either ... (or)** Use **either** when you talk about two

things or people.

Examples:

- (1) "I would like either cookies or popcorn. I can't decide."
- (2) "I would like either (of the snacks)."
- (3) "I don't want to eat either snack."

#### Neither ... (nor)

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Use **neither** (for negative sentences) when you talk about two things or people.

Examples:

- (1) "Jack has been to neither Canada nor the United States."
- (2) "Jack has been to neither (of the countries)."
- (3) There is no negative for neither.

NOTE: **Either** and **neither** can also come at the beginning of a sentence. Examples: *Either* we will go out, or we will stay at home.

**Neither** of the restaurants is open today.
